Today's Message: Triumphant Gospel- Living in the Overflow-Part 1

Galatians 2:20 ESV

20 I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

Introduction: Two statements that can make the Christian life a frustrating thing:

- 1) THE D_____ OF CHRIST ARE IMPOSSIBLE

(*Matthew 5:43-47 & Matthew 6:25-34*)

Matthew 5:43–47

43 You have heard that it was said, “You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy.” 44 But I say to you, Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, 45 so that you may be sons of your Father who is in heaven. For he makes his sunrise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the just and on the unjust. 46 For if you love those who love you, what reward do you have? Do not even the tax collectors do the same? 47 And if you greet only your brothers,

1 what more are you doing than others? Do not even the Gentiles do the same?

- 2) MY R_____ ARE INADEQUATE (*Romans 8:37 & 1 John 5:4-5*)

Romans 8:37

37 No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us.

1 John 5:4–5

4 For everyone who has been born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith. 5 Who is it that overcomes the world except the one who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?

How then, can we live triumphantly? How can I live in the Overflow?

(Galatians 2:20 is the secret of triumphant living)

HOW TO LIVE IN THE OVERFLOW?

How can you live at the dimension that God intends you to live?

*There is no substitute for victory! Either you win or you lose. Every promise that is given is given to the overcomer. You and I do not have to be under the circumstances or the challenges, you and I can be on **TOP** of the circumstances. I do not have to be the victim, I can be the victor. I do not have to be overcome, I can be the overcomer.*

I. **THE TRIUMPHANT LIFE, the overflow life IS THE E_____ LIFE**

"I am crucified with Christ" (John 12:24, Galatians 6:14)

Crucifixion was a means of execution. Jesus keeps coming back to this one secret of discipleship: Except a man deny himself, take up his cross daily, and follow me, he cannot be my disciple. The cross is the symbol of the method of execution. Jesus is saying, unless a man know what it means to die to self, he cannot be my disciple. It is the executed life, dying with Christ.

A. **The Executed Life is an A_____ P_____ Event.**
"with Christ"

B. **The Executed Life must be an App_____ Present Experience.**

How? I must condemn the flesh and I must condemn myself. (Romans 8:13) It has to be an actual experience and it has to be a daily experience. I must die daily!

Now, there are two ways to do that.

1) You must c_____ your flesh. I condemn myself.

2) Then, by faith, I must c_____ my flesh.

It has to be an **actual** experience and it has to be a **daily** experience.

That is the first key that is the first step-the executed life. Next week we will pick up with Part II of this message and that is that the Triumphant Life, the overflow life is the Exchanged Life and the Empowered Life.

II. THE TRIUMPHANT LIFE, the overflow life IS THE E LIFE

“Christ lives in me”

The measure to which the life of Jesus is released in you is determined by the measure to which you are dead to self.

I die to every ambition, and then the life, which is in you, the life of Jesus, can be released in all of its power and all of its glory!

In addition, the power of Christ is released in you only to the degree in which you are dead to self. **That is “the exchanged life.”**

That makes the Christian life p_____.

Dr. Stephen Olford said, “There is not a demand made on my life that is not at the same time a demand made upon the life of Christ in me.”

You step out of the way and die to self and you will quit worrying about it.

It is the exchanged life!

III. **THE TRIUMPHANT LIFE, the overflow life IS THE E LIFE.**

Whose faith is he living by? Paul's? Whose faith are you living by? Yours?

FAITH is counting on God's faithfulness. God operates through faith.

20 I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in/of the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

Here is what it means; **I am counting on God's faithfulness.**

Faith is merely relying that God will do what He said He'd do.

THREE THINGS YOU MUST DEAL WITH TODAY:

1) Are you willing to take the position of death?

2) Are you willing to come to the realization that it is Christ who is going to do the living in you, not you yourself, but it is Christ?

3) Will you come to the place where you take it by faith, not by feeling?

I know I have the victory, regardless of how I feel. I know by faith that I have the victory! I know that the Lord is adequate, sufficient, and equal to anything that comes to me-wonderful release and blessed assurance!
