CHOIR GUIDELINES

- Culture - As we embrace a true culture of joy, enthusiasm, and freedom, we aim to be judgment free, gossip free, and clique free zones. We will be respectful of one another, and allow leadership only to provide directives.

- Attendance - The expectation is that everyone attends all rehearsals and minister at all weekend services. There are some exceptions as arranged through Choir leadership. We ask that choir is meaningfully prioritized and planned for in your overall schedule. We need you! If you cannot attend a service or rehearsal, or will be late, please notify us through our system attendance software. (We will train you how to do this.)
- Preparation Materials - Recordings of the songs and lyrics are provided ahead of time using the Planning Center Online (PCO) app. You will receive an invitation (link) from us to sign up. Songs should be learned ahead of rehearsal.
- Serving Within the Choir - We have many people within the choir that are serving in many helpful ways. Even small tasks per week help our choir remain organized and efficient. Those that are interested in serving in this way should email mpulley@coloradocommunity.org.
- Choir Brunch (Potluck) - The choir brunch will be immediately following soundcheck on Sunday ministry dates. Members can arrive as early as 7:45 AM to set up brunch items in the Youth Rec Room. Bringing food is optional, but all are encouraged to participate in eating and fellowshiping together. It is during this time that there will be opportunities to share praise reports/prayer requests.
- Greenroom Space - The Youth Auditorium will be available to choir members throughout all services as a "greenroom" type space, and also for storage. However, please keep valuables on your person. Please refrain from using the actual Worship Arts Greenroom during choir weekends.
- Sermon - Choir members are encouraged to listen to at least one sermon during the weekend service.
- Timing - About 10 minutes prior to the 1st service each ministry day, we will come together to pray in the Youth Auditorium, and then proceed to the stage. The prayer times will be led by the Choir Leadership Team. Members should plan to walk onto the risers two minutes prior to the start of service ahead of the start of service.

- If you miss the start of the ministry time, please don't walk on stage during that song, rather, wait until the next break, after the Call to Worship or before the Offering. If you miss those breaks, it means you should wait until the next service.
- Be Aware of Those Around You - Since we rehearse and perform in fairly close quarters, please be aware of and respect your colleagues as you worship.
- Smells - Please don't wear cologne or perfume. We don't all agree on what smells good, plus some fragrances can cause others to sneeze or have headaches. Avoid eating fragrant foods just before rehearsals and ministry weekend times.
- Hygiene - Please practice good oral hygiene and good overall hygiene.

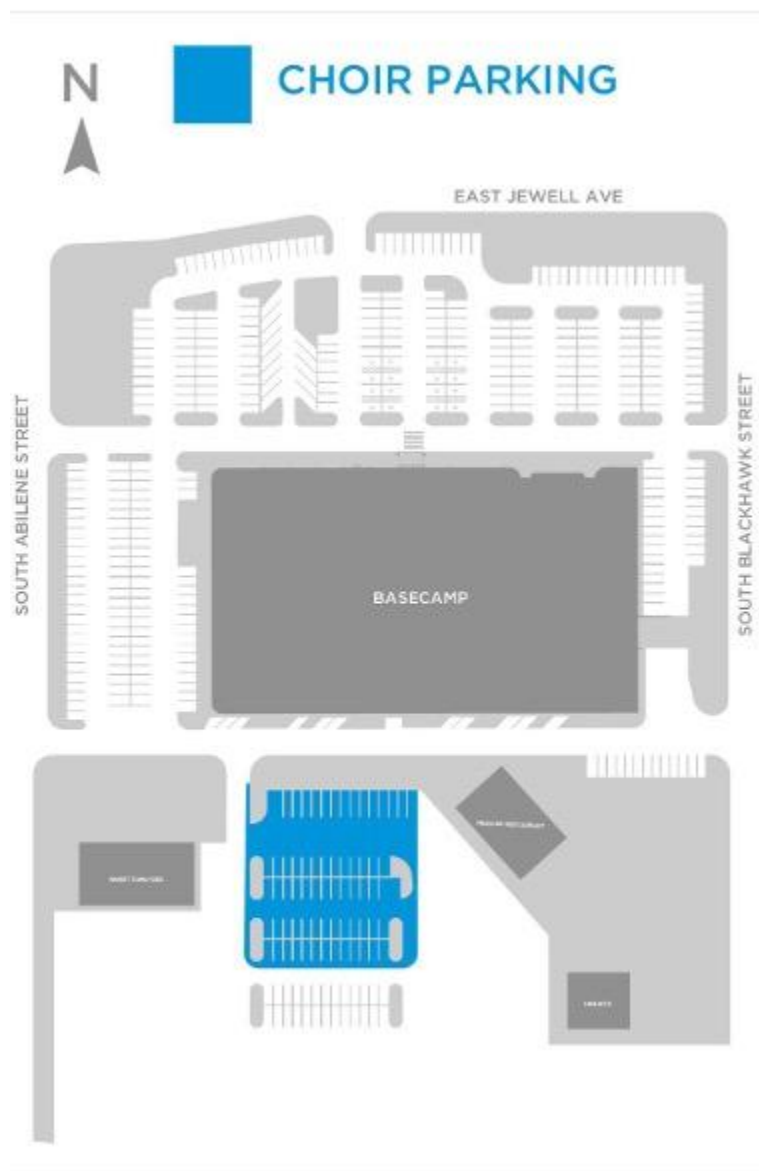

PARKING GUIDELINES

Please observe our parking guidelines (for those who are able). Please park in the lot just south of the church, as indicated in the diagram. We have approval to park in this lot. We would like to serve our congregation in this way by making the closest spaces to the church accessible to them.





DRESS GUIDELINES

With our clothing, we should always remember who we are reflecting and representing - our church, our staff, our leadership, the congregation. Most importantly, we want to honor our Lord and Savior, Jesus. We are on stage & camera, so please dress appropriately, not drawing undue attention to yourself. We do aim for freedom to dress comfortably, and to express our own individual styles.

We ask that you keep these requests in mind when you go to your closets:

- Every ministry weekend, we will work from a predetermined color palette. Don't fret if you don't have those exact colors, as black and gray are always allowed as well. Solids are preferred but not required. Please avoid busy patterns.
- Please make an effort to be presentable. Jeans are appropriate, however, ripped jeans revealing substantial skin are not appropriate.
- Avoid clothing with symbols or messages (this includes sport teams clothing) that could cause distraction from our time of worship.
- Avoid wearing white, cream, or light beige as a primary color in your outfit, because it can make you "glow" under the lights.
- Avoid neon type colors that could draw undue attention.
- Please do not wear hats as they can distract or fall off.
- Please avoid tight shirts.
- Men: Please do not wear your pants in a sagging fashion.
- Ladies: Please keep skirts & dresses at a reasonable length, because there will be a considerable amount of movement.
- Ladies: Avoid low-rise pants where you are at risk of revealing undergarments.
- Ladies: Avoid skin tight body dresses, revealing cleavage or midsections
- Ladies: Sheer clothing becomes more sheer under the lights, so layer as necessary.
- Ladies: Please accompany sheer or thin leggings with a long top or dress that adequately covers front and back. We may be jumping, etc. so several inches of length to supplement may be necessary.
