



Three Services FAQs

Why are we adding a third service?

Our church family is growing, which is wonderful! During the first half of 2026, we've averaged between 900 and 1,000 people on Sundays, and we anticipate that number will continue to increase this fall. Facility-wise, we have some pinch points, particularly in our parking lot and Xtreme Kids wing. We've been sensing Jesus asking us to create capacity for more growth in our church, which is why we're adding a third service.

What are the new service times?

Our new service times will be Sunday mornings at 8:30AM, 10:00AM, & 11:45AM.

When do the new service times begin?

Our new service times will begin on Sunday, September 13, 2026, with our Fall Kickoff. We'll be serving pancakes after every service!

Will all three services be the same?

Yes! All three services will be the same, and we're aiming to keep each service to 1 hour in length. The services will be a little shorter, intentional, but not rushed.

Can I still watch the services online?

Absolutely! We plan to livestream our 8:30AM and 10:00AM services.

Will kids' programs be offered at all three services?

Yes! We'll have full Xtreme Kids programming available at all three services.

Which service should I attend?

You're welcome to attend whichever service best fits your schedule. We expect the 10:00AM service to be the busiest. If you're able, we encourage you to consider attending either the 8:30AM or 11:45AM service.
