Senior High Coordinator

Employment Type: Contract position, August 24, 2026, to June 30, 2027.

Hours: Part-time, approximately 15 hours per week.

Closing Date: Position will remain open until a suitable candidate is found.

Purpose: The Senior High Coordinator helps senior high students practice the way of Jesus and be Good News to their neighbours by creating welcoming, engaging, and discipleship-focused environments where students can encounter Jesus, build meaningful relationships, and take next steps in faith.

Responsibilities:

Youth Ministry Coordination (75%)

- Provide leadership and oversight for weekly Senior High ministry environments, with a primary focus on Wednesday evening programming.
- Coordinates volunteers and weekly ministry elements to ensure programs are organized, engaging, and aligned with the vision of the Youth Ministry.
- Works alongside the Youth & Young Adults Pastor to plan and execute ministry calendars, events, retreats, service opportunities, and outreach initiatives.
- Communicates regularly with students, parents, and volunteers regarding ministry opportunities, events and next steps.
- Assists in the preparation and delivery of teaching content, including teaching approximately once per month and supporting volunteer communicators.
- Helps create welcoming environments that encourage connection, belonging, and spiritual growth for students.
- Ensures ministry environments operate in accordance with StAAC policies, including Plan to Protect standards.

Student Discipleship & Care (20%)

- Builds intentional relationships with students and their families
- Supports small group leaders in creating meaningful discipleship environments.
- Follows up with new students and families to help them connect into the life of the ministry.
- Provides appropriate pastoral care, encouragement, and prayer for students while partnering with the Youth & Young Adults Pastor on more complex situations.

Other Responsibilities (5%)

- Participates in Youth Ministry Team meetings, planning conversations, and staff gatherings as requested.
- Performs duties as assigned by the Youth & Young Adults Pastor that align with the purpose of this role.
