The opportunity:

Looking for an opportunity to make a difference this summer? St. Albert Alliance Church is seeking two individuals who are passionate about making a Kingdom impact while gaining valuable knowledge and experience in kids ministry.

The Kids Summer Coordinators will assist with the planning, preparation and delivery of summer programming for preschool and elementary students in St. Albert and surrounding areas. This includes organizing kids day camps and leading weekend programs. The role involves creative planning, administration, teaching lessons, as well as leading games and activities. It also includes supporting leadership development and volunteer coordination.

The selected candidates will gain valuable skills and hands-on experience in engagement with kids, teamwork and event leadership. Coordinators will develop key skills in adaptability, collaboration, communication, creativity, and problem solving by working closely with a mentor and diverse team of volunteers. Through structured one-on-one mentoring from our Kids & Family Pastor, candidates will receive guidance, career related training, and access to learning resources to support their professional development.

This position reports to the Kids & Family Pastor and the Kids Ministry Team, where applicable.

Minimum qualifications include:

- Previous experience working with kids in faith-based children's programs and activities would be an asset.
- Qualified candidates must be able to work effectively with a diverse staff and volunteers in a variety of settings.
- Strong communication, organization, and computer skills.
- Applicants must be between the ages of 15-30.
- Be a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident.

Other Requirements for the position are:

- Commit to following and live by the StAAC Ministry Covenant and adhere to the policies and procedures of the Staff Handbook.
