



"10 Tweets" from Ephesians 1

1. The name Ephesians means, "fully purposed." God has called us to be "fully purposed" in Christ that we might bring praise to His glory! (Eph. 1)
2. The Book of Ephesians reminds believers of their WEALTH in Christ, encourages them to walk WORTHY of their calling despite their environment, and equips them for their WARFARE facing powers and principalities of spiritual wickedness. (Ephesians)
3. God has given every believer (even you!) two things: GRACE and PEACE (Eph. 1:2). How are you handling them? Are they visible in your life?
4. God has blessed you with "all spiritual blessings." A "blessing" is not just for your benefit – it is to EQUIP you for a work – HIS WORK. (Eph. 1:3-5)
5. God has equipped the believer with grace, peace and spiritual blessings in Christ so that we might be HOLY and WITHOUT BLAME – that is how we can bring Him MAXIMUM GLORY. (Eph. 1:4). Holy in our walks, holy in our homes, holy in our interactions – this is what God intended all along. (Eph. 1:4)
6. God wants us all to know clearly where we stand with Him – ACCEPTED IN THE BELOVED. Nothing can ever take you out of that! (Eph. 1:6)
7. Understanding the ORDER of your salvation matters because it shapes your whole view of that moment you were placed in Christ.
 - Christ first took your place on the cross and through His blood paid for your redemption. (Eph. 1:7)
 - ANY soul that takes that fact at face value and calls upon the name of the LORD shall be saved (Rom. 10:13).
 - At that moment, the Holy Spirit SEALS your salvation forever! That is some GRACE! (Eph. 1:12-13)
8. We all have a REPUTATION. It is directly tied to our heart attitude in two categories: your faith in Christ and your love of the saints (Eph. 1:15). What is your reputation saying about you?
9. Jesus is the embodiment of all that God said He gave to the believer in Chapter 1 (grace, peace, blessed, beloved, etc). Therefore, He is the HEAD of the body (the Church). Practically speaking, is HE the HEAD of YOUR body daily? (Eph. 1:22-23)
10. What you believe will affect the way you live. The book of Ephesians reveals that our daily lifestyle REFLECTS our heart attitude toward our salvation and our understanding of our position in the body Christ.
