



“10 Tweets” from Ephesians 5:15-33

1. This week we continue in God’s “how-to” manual when it comes to **walking WORTHY** of the glory due His name. It’s interesting not only to consider what He focused on – but also what He did not focus on in a worthy walk.
2. In Ephesians 5, we have already seen God tell us to walk worthy by walking in **LOVE** and by walking in **LIGHT**. Now, we see God tell us to walk worthy by walking **CIRCUMSPECTLY, redeeming the time, understanding the will of the Lord**.
3. The word **CIRCUMSPECT** means, “watchful on all sides; with careful examination.” That is exactly how God wants us to walk with the limited amount of time we have here on this earth because we have an incredible vocation we have been called to carry out (Eph. 4:1)!
4. “Redeeming the time, because the days are evil.” Yes, any way you slice it, we live in a wicked, evil world that has been entirely corrupted by sin. And on top of that, time is not on our side!
5. When committing your available time, a good question ask is, “How much does this decision cost, and who is paying for it?” Often, through the best of intentions, we “write checks” with time that others will cash...be it our spouses...our kids...our God. How are you spending the time God has given you? Are you redeeming it wisely or spending it foolishly (Eph. 5:15-17)? Better yet, next time you consider committing to something, ask yourself, “How will this decision affect my ability to **WALK WORTHY** of the vocation to which my Lord and Saviour called me?”
6. God calls us to walk worthy by walking circumspectly in the **SPIRIT**. He compares this with being “under the influence” of wine...meaning, if you want to “stay under the influence, you’ve got to keep drinking.” Are you partaking in the Word of God and Spirit of God enough that someone would think you’re “**under the influence**” and **filled with the Spirit**?
7. God calls us to walk worthy by walking circumspectly in **SUBMISSION** to one another in the fear of God. That involves seeing brothers and sisters in Christ as God sees them: redeemed by the blood, filled with the Spirit. Is that what you see? Or is your flesh blinding you to who they are in Christ?
8. God calls us to walk worthy by walking circumspectly in **MARRIAGE**: one of the greatest pictures of a relationship with Christ that God created.
9. Wives, God is a God of order. Like the relationship between the Father, Son, and Holy Ghost, God created headship in marriage. He is calling you to walk worthy by walking circumspectly in **biblical submission to your own husband, as unto Christ**. This walk pictures the bride of Christ.
10. Husbands, you are called to walk worthy by **loving your wife as Christ loved the Church, and as you love yourself. Sacrificially. Unconditionally. Taking initiative and meeting her needs.**
