What time are your services and where are they held?

Sundays at 9:00am and 11:00am, lasting approximately 75 minutes. We are located at 11525 Greenspring Avenue, Lutherville, Maryland 21093.

What is a worship service like at Resurrection?

In our worship, our goal is that the message and Spirit of Christ brings the liturgy alive enough so that everyone will feel welcome, comfortable, and able to connect with what is happening in any service irrespective of their church background. Do I have to be a member at Resurrection to take Communion?

All who profess faith in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior are welcomed to receive the Sacrament with us, regardless of a person's denomination or church background.
