

# JUST SAY YES!

**FAMILY DEVOTION: The Woman With the Alabaster Jar**



**THE BUZZ:** "If Jesus Needs It, I'll Say Yes!"



**THE POWER VERSE:** "The earth is the Lord's, and everything in it. The world and all its people belong to him." – Psalm 24:1



**THE TAKEAWAY:** When Jesus Asks – Say "Yes!"

**SAY:** On the very first Palm Sunday, people celebrated as Jesus came into the city, but before that, Jesus told His disciples where to find a donkey and to say, "The Lord needs it." The owner of the donkey had a choice. He could keep it for himself, or he could trust Jesus and let it go. Let's find out what choice he made!

**READ:** Luke 19:28–35

## DISCUSS:

- What did Jesus tell the disciples to go find in a nearby village?
- What did Jesus tell them to tell the owners?
- Did the owners allow the donkey to go?
- What did the people wave in the air as Jesus arrived in Jerusalem?
- How did God use the donkey?
- What is something you can say "yes" to Jesus about?

**SAY:** The donkey's owner probably didn't know how important his "yes" would be, but God used it in a big way! That's how it works with us too! When we trust Jesus and say "yes," He uses what we give Him for something bigger than we can imagine.

So, when Jesus asks for our time, our kindness, or our help, we can trust Him. The best answer is always: "Yes, Jesus!"

**PRAY:** Pray together and ask God what He wants from each family member. Spend time committing to God your "yes!"
