FAMILY DEVOTION: A Second Chance



THE BUZZ: God will give me a second chance!



THE POWER VERSE: “But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.” - Acts 1:8



THE TAKEAWAY: Give your life to Jesus and follow His plan!

SAY: Everyone makes mistakes! Sometimes we make bad choices, say hurtful words, disobey, or do things we wish we could undo. When that happens, we can feel guilty or ashamed. We might even wonder, “Can God still love me after what I’ve done?”

The story of Saul reminds us of an amazing truth: no one is too far gone for Jesus to reach.

READ: Acts 9:1-19

DISCUSS:

- What was the name of the man?
- What was Saul doing before he met Jesus?
- Where was Saul going when Jesus appeared to him?
- What happened to Saul after he encountered Jesus?
- What happened when Ananias prayed for Saul?
- How can God use us even after we make bad choices?

SAY: Jesus is full of grace and mercy. He doesn’t give up on us when we mess up. Instead, He forgives us, changes us, and helps us become who He created us to be. Our mistakes do not have the final word. Jesus does! God sees who we can become when we surrender our lives to Him. He is the God of second chances!

PRAY: Pray for your children to surrender their lives to God and allow Him to give them a second chance to follow His plan!
