# Bethany UMC – “He Is Risen: More Than a Moment”



What if Easter is not just something we celebrate once a year but something we can step into every day?

The resurrection of Jesus is not just a moment in history, it's a power that is still at work right now. Discover what the resurrection means for your real life.

Because He is risen: Hope is alive. Your story is not finished. Something new is possible.

The life of Jesus did not stop at the empty tomb. It continued through the lives of His people. It continues in us.

## **April 5: Easter Sunday**

Ep 1. - He Is Risen. This Changes Everything

Matthew 28:1–10; 1 Peter 1:3–4; 2 Corinthians 5:17

It all begins at the empty tomb. On that first Easter morning, everything changed. What looked final was not final. What felt lost was not lost. What seemed over was not over. What if that is still true today? And what if the story did not end at the tomb but continued in the lives of those who followed Jesus?

Come and discover that the resurrection is not just something to believe in. It is something to step into.

## **April 12**

Ep 2. – Hope for the Broken

Luke 7:11–17; Acts 3:1–10; Psalm 34:18; Romans 8:26–28

Life does not always hold together the way we hoped it would. When things fall apart, it is easy to wonder where God is. But the story of Jesus shows us something powerful. He meets people right in the middle of their pain.

And after the resurrection, we see that same compassion continue as His followers begin to carry His love into the lives of others. God does not wait for everything to be fixed before showing up. He meets us right in the middle of it.

## **April 19**

Ep 3. – Hope for the Weary

John 11:1–44; Acts 16:25–34; Isaiah 40:31; 2 Corinthians 4:16–18

Have you ever prayed and wondered if God was listening? Have you ever waited and felt like nothing was changing? You are not alone.

Even in the early church, there were moments when everything felt stuck, delayed, or uncertain and yet God was still working in ways no one could see.

This week we discover that waiting is not wasted. Even when we cannot see it, God is at work. Even when it feels late, God is moving.

## **April 26**

Ep 4. – Hope for the Undeserving

Luke 23:32–43; Acts 9:1–19; Ephesians 2:8–9; Romans 10:9–10

What if grace is bigger than your past? What if it is not too late? What if you have not gone too far?

From the cross to the early church, we see the same truth again and again. Lives are changed not because people earn it, but because God gives it.

Grace is not earned. It is given. And it is still changing lives today.

**This Easter season, do not just celebrate the resurrection. Step into it.**
