August Mission Focus: The New Community Shelter

The New Community Shelter is the only Emergency Shelter in Brown County open year-round that serves homeless adult men and women. In addition to our Emergency Shelter Program, the New Community Shelter has provided a Transitional Living Program and a Community Meal Program since 1994.

Bethany is honored to serve lunch at the Shelter on the second Saturday of each month, providing not just a meal but a sense of community for those in need. What sets us apart from other organizations is that we bring our own food to prepare and serve, allowing us to make the meal more personal and meaningful. In response to the growing needs of those we serve, we've added homemade soup to our menu each month, which has increased our monthly budget by \$60.

Your generous financial gifts will make a real and immediate impact, helping us cover the additional costs of providing meals each month. With your support, we can continue to meet the growing needs of our community and create lasting change.
