July Mission Focus: Kingdom Come

Kingdom Come Food Pantry opened in the Fall of 2005 in Oconto Falls, Wisconsin, serving the needs of nine households. Within six months of opening, the pantry began opening every Tuesday so that clients could come weekly to shop for their households. Over the years the need for the food pantry has grown, and the pantry has grown to meet that need. Today the pantry serves more than 450 families on a weekly basis each Tuesday between the hours of 10 am - 6 pm. (kingdomcomefoodpantry.com)
