


Thank You's

Lent is an invitation to slow down, draw near to Jesus, and prepare our hearts for Easter. This year, we invite you to walk with us on The Road to Resurrection, a five-week journey through the final moments of Jesus' life and what they mean for us today.

March 1 — Episode 1: Forgiveness & Grace (Luke 23:32–43)

Jesus begins the journey by offering immediate grace and forgiveness to the undeserving.

March 8 — Episode 2: Family (John 19:25–27)

At the cross, Jesus forms a new family shaped by sacrificial love.

March 15 — Episode 3: Forsaken and Thirsty (Psalm 22:1–11; Matthew 27:45–50)

Jesus enters our deepest suffering so no part of our pain is beyond redemption.

March 22 — Episode 4: It Is Finished (John 19:28–30)

Christ declares the work complete and invites us to live from His finished victory.

March 29 — Episode 5: Surrender (Palm Sunday) (Luke 19:28–40; Luke 23:44–49)

Jesus shows that surrender to the Father is the pathway to resurrection life.


