Mission In Action

Every month, Bethany designates a monthly mission to support through our giving. You are invited give towards these missions as you feel called. Our missions for the next couple of months are:

April Mission Focus: The New Community Shelter

The 2nd Saturday of every month, Bethany serves lunch at the shelter. The funds go towards providing the food for these meals. Currently, we spend around \$200 a month on food.

May Mission Focus: Pastor's Emergency Fund

At Bethany, we believe generosity is about more than meeting a moment. It is about helping create a path forward. One of the ways we live that out is through the Pastor's Emergency Assistance Fund. This fund allows us to respond when someone in our community is facing an immediate, short-term crisis. It provides timely support in situations where a simple act of generosity can bring stability, relief, and hope. Each request is prayerfully discerned, with a focus on offering one-time or very limited assistance that can help someone take their next step forward during a difficult moment.



At this time, the Pastor's Emergency Assistance Fund has been fully used, and we now have an opportunity to rebuild it so we can continue responding when those moments arise. When you give to this fund, you are not just meeting a need. You are offering care, compassion, and a tangible expression of God's love in a time of crisis. You are helping us put our faith into action in a very real way. Speak to Pastor Robb if you, or someone you know needs assistance.

June Mission Focus: UMCOR

Global Ministries and the United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR) strengthen United Methodist response to humanitarian crises around the world through disaster relief and recovery, migrant and refugee support, environmental sustainability, agriculture and food security. 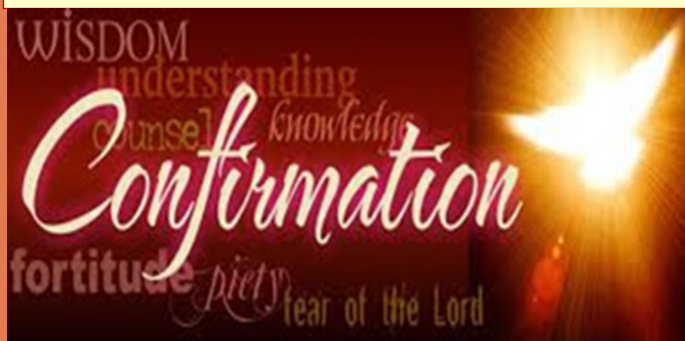

Even helping **one Sunday** can make a meaningful difference. Your willingness to share a ride helps ensure that no one feels disconnected from the community they love.

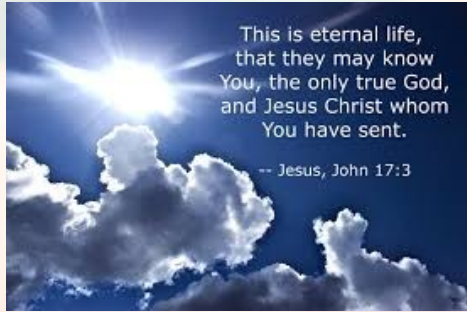

Celebrating Pastor Robb's Doctor of Ministry Degree

On Saturday, May 2, 2026, Pastor Robb McClintock will receive his Doctor of Ministry degree from the University of Dubuque Theological Seminary. This is the highest degree earned in ministry and recognizes him as a "Teacher of the Church." It marks an important milestone and reflects years of commitment, study, and faithful leadership among us.

The work that led to this moment began in late 2020, as we were coming out of the Covid lockdowns and trying to make sense of what church life was becoming. Like many clergy leaders, Pastor Robb found himself asking, How are we going to do this? In January of 2021, a former seminary professor reached out to tell him about a new Doctor of Ministry program focused on Church Revitalization and encouraged him to consider it. The program required a three-year commitment, mostly online with one in-person week each May. Pastor Robb had real questions about whether he had the capacity, but with the encouragement of his family, the conference, and the Bethany and New Hope church families, he chose to take the step

A central concern of his doctoral work is a reality we see all around us: many churches are struggling as Christianity moves from the center of cultural influence to the margins of Western society. In that setting, it often falls to a small number of people to carry far too much responsibility, emotional weight, and urgency within the church. That kind of pressure is not healthy, and it is not sustainable.

The following reflections are drawn from Pastor Robb's doctoral dissertation, "Flourishing in the Life of God: A Trinitarian and Wesleyan Vision for Pastoral Renewal and Church Revitalization." In it, he looks beyond the challenges facing today's churches to the importance of shared vision, participatory leadership, and practices that nurture spiritual vitality, trust, and a shared sense of purpose. Central to the work is the conviction that renewed spiritual life, rooted in shared participation in the life of the Triune God, equips congregations to meet their communities with compassion. As part of this journey, Pastor Robb made intentional changes in his own life, paying closer attention to his health through diet, exercise, and Sabbath time. Along the way, Bethany became both a beneficiary and, at times, a testing ground for practices and ideas from the program, including the Congregational Assessment Tool and Dynamite Prayer. While not directly connected to the seminary program, many of the values that shape the MCCI process were also present. We continue that work today as God calls us into broader participation, deeper engagement, and new ways of connecting with our community.

Congratulations to the Reverend Doctor Robb McClintock on this significant milestone. We celebrate not only the degree itself, but the ongoing work of renewal that continues to shape our congregation and our shared calling.

You are invited to wear red on Pentecost Sunday



On Pentecost Sunday, we remember the day the disciples received the Holy Spirit in a special way. The story in Acts 2 describes a powerful wind and tongues of fire as the Holy Spirit was poured out on people from all over the world who came to Jerusalem to celebrate a Jewish feast. At the first Pentecost over 3000 people were baptized, creating the first church. This is why Pentecost is known as the birthday of the Christian church.

The word Pentecost comes from a Greek word meaning fiftieth. The Jewish Festival of Pentecost (called Shavuot, meaning "weeks" in Hebrew) falls on the fiftieth day after the original Passover. On that day, God gave the Torah to Moses on Mount Sinai. The Christian festival of Pentecost falls on the 50th day after the resurrection of Jesus.

Pentecost for Christians culminates the celebration and work of the church begun on Easter Day. In much of early Christianity, Easter Day (not Pentecost) became the primary day for baptisms. After their baptism, the newly baptized were then trained in basic Christian doctrine, including the meaning of the sacraments they had now experienced, as they prepared to take up their ministries in the life of the church. On Pentecost, Christians primarily celebrate the commissioning of new members into ministry. Some do this through services of confirmation on Pentecost. And still others have also, historically, offered baptism on Pentecost as well. (Information from www.umc.org)
