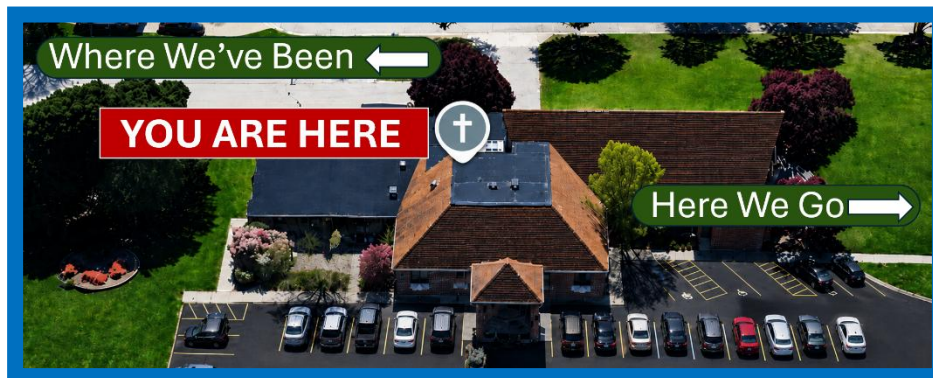

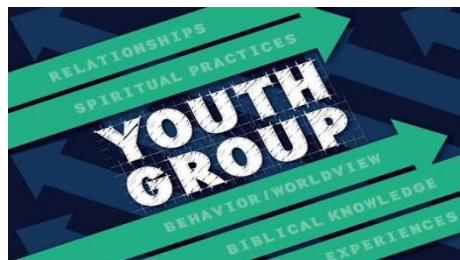
Youth & Parents Getting' Together Sunday, September 13

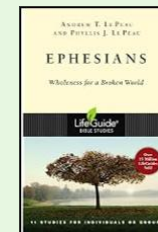
