DISCIPLESHIP

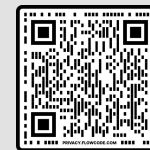

GOOD STANDING

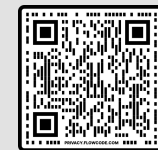
The mark of a Christian, and the mark of a church partner in good standing, is not perfection. Rather, it is someone who is constantly revising their affairs in order to carry through with their decision to follow Jesus. It is a persistent fight of faith that recognizes sin as sin, confesses it, and by grace turns from it again and again.

RADIUS Church is merely one of thousands of local expressions of the body of Christ throughout the world. In the spirit of unity, if you are leaving another church body to partner here, we ask that you, where possible, have a conversation with the leadership of that church to explain to them why you are leaving to preserve that relationship.

Partnering at RADIUS is a simple two-step process. First, complete the Partner Spiritual Health Self-Assessment to reflect on your growth as a disciple and ask for guidance on next steps. Then, sign the Partner Covenant as your commitment to function as part of the RADIUS Church family.

CARE AND AUTHORITY

Our directional elders commit to pursuing the Spirit's guidance as they lead the church and steward her resources. Our local shepherding elders and pastors commit to caring for the church by shepherding her well, praying for her, teaching the Scriptures, equipping people for ministry, protecting her from false teachers, and lovingly exercising correction when necessary.

RADIUS Partners commit to an affectionate care and watchfulness over each other, and as occasion may require, will humbly and gently confront one another and receive correction from one another in accordance with a New Testament understanding of church discipline and restoration.

MY COMMITMENT

FAITH

I have, by faith, received Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and have been baptized in His name. I affirm the Apostles Creed and Foundational Doctrines of RADIUS Church. (Rom. 6:3-5)

UNITY

I will guard my tongue from destructive gossip, resist jumping to conclusions, and have courageous conversations with others as I work for the good of all partners and RADIUS Church. (Eph. 4:1-3)

PARTICIPATION

I will regularly participate in the life of RADIUS Church by attending weekly worship services, serving, engaging in Biblical community (RADIUS Groups or similar) and sharing the Gospel with my radius. (Heb. 10:25)

OUR FOUNDATIONAL DOCTRINES

RADIUS Church joins the historic Church in affirming the truths of the Apostles Creed:

"I believe in God the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ His only Son our Lord: Who was conceived of the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, and was crucified, dead, and buried; he descended to the dead. The third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God the Father Almighty. From thence he shall come to judge the living and the dead. We believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy universal Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen."

In addition to the Apostles Creed, RADIUS Partners join with historical Christianity in affirming the following:

- God created men and women in His perfect image as two distinct genders, and together these gender distinctions fully express God's image. Our rebellion against God has tarnished this image, leaving us enslaved to our sin and deserving His eternal wrath. (Gen. 1:26-27; Rom. 3:23, 6:23)
- Marriage is a lifelong covenant relationship between one man and one woman that is designed to reflect the relationship between Christ and His Church. (Eph. 5:22-33)
- Jesus' death and resurrection absorbed God's wrath over our sin and purchased new life for all who believe in Him. This new life is accessed by faith and brings forgiveness, reconciliation with God, and eternal adoption into God's family as sons and daughters. (Eph. 2:12-13)
- The Bible is the story of God's relationship with mankind, revealing a perfect and loving Creator working to restore a rebellious and sinful creation. The 39 books of the Old Testament and 27 books of the New Testament are inspired in their original form and therefore completely true and authoritative. (2 Tim. 3:16-17)

PHILOSOPHY OF MINISTRY

Every person has a unique sphere of influence - what we call your radius. Your radius is made up of your home, your world, and your church family where you gather to worship, learn, and grow together. Healthy disciples live with intentionality in our radius as we walk with God, love our neighbor, do our job, live generously, and engage with our church family. As we stay rooted in God's truth and dependent on His Spirit, our lives bear fruit that point others to Jesus and multiply disciples in every part of our radius.
