**Scripture: Genesis 3:1-13**

The story of Bible: Creation, Fall, Redemption, Restoration

CREATION: Being made in the image of God implies 4 loving relationships:

- A love for God and to love what God loves.
- A love for one another. (Matt. 22:39; Mark 12:31; Luke 10:27)
- A love for self. (Matt. 22:39; Mark 12:31; Luke 10:27)
- A Love for God’s creation.

FALL: Sin brought brokenness in man/woman and all of creation. (Genesis 3:1–7)

Satan’s Temptation Tactics (Satan is not creative, but he is consistent.)

1. Twist God’s Word. (Gen. 1:1)
2. Tempt you to doubt and forget God’s Word. (Gen. 1:2-3)
3. Contradict God’s Word. (Gen. 1:4; 2:16-17)
4. Tempt you to doubt God and your identity in God. (Gen. 1:5; John 10:10)
5. Turn on you once you sin. (Gen. 1:6-7) (The tempter becomes the accuser.)

Five Ways Sin Makes Us Stupid (Gen. 3:7-13)

1. We cover our sinful shame with insufficient coverings. (vs. 7-8)
2. We run from the only one who can truly help us - Father God. (v. 8)
3. We lie to ourselves about God’s efforts to help. (vs. 9-10)
4. We blame God and others for our sinful choices. (vs. 11-12)
5. We isolate ourselves and others. (v. 13)
