

Everyone who comes to Wildwood experiences the unconditional love and compassion of Jesus Christ, recognizes they belong, and is empowered to serve others.






What is a discipleship pathway?


MAKE PRAYER A REGULAR PART OF YOUR LIFE

LEVEL UP IN YOUR BIBLE STUDY

Developing this discipline of daily reading can be transformational in your life.

DEVELOP SPIRITUAL DISCIPLINES (PRACTICES)

Reading daily devotions; lectio divina; prayer, journaling, fasting, meditation, enjoying God's creation without distractions.

GIVE REGULARLY

Giving to God is an act of worship and generosity which grows you, the giver. It not only deepens your relationship with God, but demonstrates your trust in God. No amount is too big or too small in the eyes of God.

WORK TOWARDS TITHING


Giving 10% of your income (tithing) is a sacrifice that may require a shift in your priorities. Set a goal for how and when you will be able to tithe cheerfully.
