TIME

Parents, build intentional time into the rhythm of family life for the purpose of thinking about, talking about, and living out the gospel. Use the guide below for family worship.

READ

2 Corinthians 1:3–5

- What name is used to describe God in these verses?
- How does the Holy Spirit comfort His children?
- When do you need comfort? What or who helps you to feel better, calm or safe?
- How does God feel when His children are hurting?
- What are some ways that God's children can turn to the Lord for comfort?
- How would remembering the attributes of God (refuge, wise, loving, good, attentive, etc.) bring comfort in a time of trouble?

PRAY

Take turns praying together.

- **Praise:** God, You are... (refer to His attributes)
- **Thanksgiving:** God, I thank You for...
- **Lament:** God, I am sad about...
- **Confession:** God, forgive me for... and help me forgive...
- **Request:** God, I ask You for...

SING

Play your favorite worship songs and sing together. Make up motions to your favorite parts!



MOMENTS

As a family, think about someone that you know who is facing suffering. Consider how you can provide comfort by making them a card, bringing them a meal, or even just praying for that person together as a family. Talk about how God's children can comfort others because they have first received comfort from Him.
