TIME

Parents, build intentional time into the rhythm of family life for the purpose of thinking about, talking about, and living out the gospel. Use the guide below for family worship.

READ

Genesis 24:27, Deuteronomy 7:9

- Why is Abraham's servant praising God?
- What does it mean that God is faithful?
- When is it easy for you to trust in God? When is it hard?
- How does this passage remind us that God is trustworthy?
- What promises of God are God's children waiting on today?
- What can God's children do when it feels hard to trust in God?

PRAY

Take turns praying together.

- **Praise:** God, You are... (refer to His attributes)
- **Thanksgiving:** God, I thank you for...
- **Lament:** God, I am sad about...
- **Confession:** God, forgive me for... and help me forgive...
- **Request:** God, I ask you for...

SING

Play your favorite worship songs and sing together. Make up motions to your favorite parts!

Write Deuteronomy 7:9 in a place that is visible in your home, such as posted on the refrigerator or on a mirror. As a family, take opportunities to remind one another that God is faithful and trustworthy, even when things are hard.
