Discuss God's Word and God's World

Important: *The goal is to use this Guide to spark sanctifying conversation and opportunities for intercessory prayer, not to “get through” every question like a checklist. Feel free to linger on the questions that best facilitate that for your group.*

Start here: *Take a few moments to share and reflect together on what stood out to you from this week's Bible passage and the sermon about it.*

1. What evidence of God's goodness have you seen recently?
2. When is it hardest for you to believe that God's love for you is steadfast and unchanging? Why?
3. What do you think it means to genuinely cry out to God? What keeps you from crying out to God sooner when you're facing a difficult situation?
4. Is there an area where you've been trying to solve problems on your own instead of crying out to God?
5. Which of the four situations—lost, imprisoned, sick, or caught in a storm—best reflects a season you've experienced in life?
6. How can you consider the steadfast love of the Lord in your life and what impact will that make?
