TIME

Parents, build intentional time into the rhythm of family life for the purpose of thinking about, talking about, and living out the gospel. Use the guide below for family worship.

READ

John 14:16–17

- Who is the Holy Spirit?
- What does the Holy Spirit do?
- Talk about four of the ways we learned the Holy Spirit helps God's children:
 - Reminds
 - Teaches
 - Convicts
 - Strengthens their prayers

PRAY

Take turns praying together.

- **Praise:** God, You are... (refer to His attributes)
- **Thanksgiving:** God, I thank You for...
- **Lament:** God, I am sad about...
- **Confession:** God, forgive me for... and help me forgive...
- **Request:** God, I ask You for...

SING

Play your favorite worship songs and sing together. Make up motions to your favorite parts! Consider listening to "Wherever I Go" by Ellie Holcomb.



MOMENTS

We want our kids to know that the Holy Spirit is God, the Holy Spirit is good and the Holy Spirit loves to help God's children. God's children can always ask Him for help. Consider writing notes to stick in their lunch boxes, on their mirror or truly anywhere to remind them that the Holy Spirit helps God's children. You may even consider making bracelets or drawing pictures! Anything to help your children to remember to talk to God because He loves to help His children!
