## TIME

Parents, build intentional time into the rhythm of family life for the purpose of thinking about, talking about, and living out the gospel. Use the guide below for family worship.

## READ

### Matthew 6:9

- Is this a prayer of praise, thanksgiving, lament, confession or request?
- What are we asking God to do in this prayer?
- What does the word hallow mean? (To set something apart as holy, to glorify it)
- How does God glorify His name?
- Whose name alone should be glorified?
- What are you tempted to give glory to other than God?
- How can you practice giving God glory this week?

## PRAY

Take turns praying together.

- **Praise:** God, You are... (refer to His attributes)
- **Thanksgiving:** God, I thank You for...
- **Lament:** God, I am sad about...
- **Confession:** God, forgive me for... and help me forgive...
- **Request:** God, I ask You for...

## SING

Play your favorite worship songs and sing together. Make up motions to your favorite parts!



## MOMENTS

All summer long we are talking about the names of God! Spend time as a family decorating something with your name on it! Maybe it is a sign for your bedroom door or a t-shirt. Names are a big deal! They can tell us about people and their reputation. Talk about what it means to have a "good name." Ask them what God's name tell us about who He is and what He has done. Remind them that God's name is the greatest name with the best reputation! **God's name is above all names.**
