TIME

Parents, build intentional time into the rhythm of family life for the purpose of thinking about, talking about, and living out the gospel. Use the guide below for family worship.

READ

Luke 5:1–11

- What names of God does Simon call Jesus in this passage of Scripture?
- How did Simon respond to Jesus?
- What does this passage of Scripture teach us about God?
- What does it teach us about our relationship to God?
- How do God's children respond to God? What is the right response to Jesus' lordship?
- Is it easy or hard to believe that Jesus is Lord and Master? Why or why not?
- When is it hard for you to submit to Jesus as Lord and Master?

PRAY

Take turns praying together.

- **Praise:** God, You are... (refer to His attributes)
- **Thanksgiving:** God, I thank You for...
- **Lament:** God, I am sad about...
- **Confession:** God, forgive me for... and help me forgive...
- **Request:** God, I ask You for...

SING

Play your favorite worship songs and sing together. Make up motions to your favorite parts!



MOMENTS

Go fishing together as a family! If you do not have the ability to fish, pick a different outdoor summer activity. As you fish, or spend time in nature as a family, talk about how Jesus is Lord and Master over everything. He commands the creatures, the seasons and the weather. We cannot control things like God can, and it is good that God is in control and that we are not. He is a good Lord and Master!
