TIME

Parents, build intentional time into the rhythm of family life for the purpose of thinking about, talking about, and living out the gospel. Use the guide below for family worship.

READ

Exodus 3:1–15

- Today you talked about God's name. Who did God reveal His name to? Where was he?
- What is God's name? What does it look like when we read it in Scripture?
- God's name tells us that He is self-existent. What does that mean?
- Why is God's name above every other name (more important and worthy)?
- What questions do you have about what you learned today?

PRAY

Take turns praying together.

- **Praise:** God, You are... (refer to His attributes)
- **Thanksgiving:** God, I thank You for...
- **Lament:** God, I am sad about...
- **Confession:** God, forgive me for... and help me forgive...
- **Request:** God, I ask You for...

SING

Play your favorite worship songs and sing together. Make up motions to your favorite parts!



MOMENTS

Build a campfire together! As you spend time together by the fire, talk about the story of the burning bush. What does this story teach you about who God is and what He is like?
