5. ____ A season focusing on the celebration of the Reformation and the end of the world that is coming upon us. Both **white** and **red** are used for this season.
6. ____ A season of preparation that gets us ready to celebrate Jesus’ first coming and to be ready for his second coming. The color **blue** is used throughout this season.
7. ____ The celebration of Jesus’ resurrection from the dead. The color **white** is used throughout this season.
