The children shouted for us to come, and the snake got confused and went into our open water tank. Most of the time these are cobra snakes, so it is very concerning.

My mother, Martha, and I rushed to the children. We saw the snake. The snake was very long. Martha told me to watch the snake. This made me very nervous. The snake was in the water tank for almost an hour before coming out. At that time, Martha took a pole and struck the snake on the head. She continued to strike the snake until it stopped moving.

Martha is a very brave woman. She has probably had to kill a dozen snakes in our time living here. This event reminds me of the story in Genesis chapter 3. Please continue to pray for the protection of our family and children.

They told us that our children's character was unique among all the children attending that school. They told us how our children's behavior, way of speaking, and discipline were above most of the students.

They did share with us the need to improve in several subjects such as math, science, and Telugu language grammar. We told the teacher and headmaster we would do our best to work with the children at home to improve these areas. Please continue to pray for our children to improve in these areas. Also pray for the children to have wisdom and knowledge in God's ways.

## CFM STREET EVANGELISM TEAM UPDATE AND PRAYER REQUESTS

After a long break in our street evangelism ministry work due to my father's broken arm, we again started to go out to different villages. As always, we reached out to the village head and asked for permission to enter their village and evangelize. They gave us permission.

This month we travelled around 1500 kilometers, which is about 933 Miles, to do street evangelism. We distributed Bibles to those people who needed them. We also prayed with the people regarding their prayer requests. There are lots of struggles and needs. I will share just a few of them.

### 1.PAVULURU VILLAGE

Last year we conducted street evangelism in the village of Pavuluru. There were a few people who accepted Yeshua. Those people are now part of one of our satellite churches. They contacted us and asked us to come back to their village and conduct street evangelism again. We went back to their village, and the evangelism went very well. We were able to distribute Bibles to these people.

There were a few people who attended the evangelism event who came to us with prayer requests. They told us that they had seen a lot of change in the lives of the members of this satellite church. They were wondering how these people had changed. They said that the members of this village church told them about our family and how we pray for them. They then asked us to pray for change in their lives.

During this time, my mother asked them what their struggles were. There were several women who each had been married for over 5 years but still had not conceived. They told my mother how they had seen many doctors about their infertility without success. They all shared how their families were mocking them calling them things like barren women. They were crying as they shared this with my mother.



My mother, being a smart woman, shared with these women the story of Samuel's mother and how she had agonized about not having a child. In the end, it was all about faith and God's timing. Below are the names of the women. Please pray for them in your daily prayers.

## 2. NALLAPADU VILLAGE

In this village, Joshna and I were able to talk to some young girls. Their stories are heartbreaking. These girls want to get an education, but because of the poverty of their families, they are not able to. To make matters worse, their parents are beating them and forcing them into a life of prostitution in order to earn money for the family's needs.

These girls told us they had heard about the 10 commandments. They shared that they had read about the commandment that states we are not to commit adultery. They recognized that it was a sin, but their parents were forcing them to do these sinful things. They told us that if they did not agree to do this, their parents would force them out of the house.

This breaks my heart very much. I cannot explain or share in words the way I feel. I called my parents to come talk with these girls. I shared the girl's story with my parents. My mom hugged them and prayed for them.



I am requesting that everyone reading this newsletter please pray for these young girls. We are planning to help them with new clothes and some food essentials. Please also pray for the financial resources to help them.



### 3. ADANKI VILLAGE

This village is a new place to us. We were preparing to preach the importance of salvation, but my father felt forced by the Holy Spirit to preach the healings of Jesus Christ, which are mentioned in the gospels. However, no one attended the street evangelism, but we are doing our job preaching the gospel of Yeshua.

After we finished the prayer meeting, we made an announcement asking if anyone might have a prayer request. If they did, they could come to us, and we would pray for them. We waited about 20 minutes, then we packed up our equipment.

As we were finishing packing, one boy came running up to us. He told us his mom was asking us to come to her. We went to her house where we found her sitting on a chair. She had a very large wound on her leg. For almost a year, she had spent a lot of money for medicine that did not help. She then told us, "You just preached that if you have some kind of sickness, Jesus will heal you." She then asked us, "Your God will heal me?"

We told her to keep the faith in the LORD. We told her God can heal her. We told her to take one bottle of coconut oil spray and apply it twice a day to her wound. We told her we would be praying for her, and she also needed to pray for healing.



As we continue to do street evangelism, we ask you to pray for our protection and safety. As always, we thank you for partnering with us and supporting us in your prayer life and with financial resources. We are blessed because of you, and we have been able to bless many others through your help.

## Ministry Opportunity

We have acted on an opportunity to establish Sabbath keeping churches in 12 different villages. Our family has helped provide the financial resources to rent a house in each of these 12 villages to provide a place for the people to meet. In addition, we have appointed a Corner Fringe Ministry India Associate Pastor in each village. The combined rent per month for these buildings is around \$336 per month. This provides an opportunity for people in multiple villages to observe the Sabbath and develop a Christian community.

We would like to establish at least 3 more satellite, Sabbath-keeping churches in the next year. This would add to the current expense for these churches. We consider this a great opportunity from YAWH. Would you please consider partnering with us and praying for this mission?
