Welcome to *On the Fringe*. I'm Daniel Joseph, and today I want to talk about something epic. If you've been watching the newsreels and seeing the articles come across on the

internet, you will notice something unprecedented, something that has never happened before, has taken place this week, and that is that a United States president has declared *Yerushalayim* the capital of Israel. Historic. This is an act of prophetic proportions, and we are embarking on very exciting days.

Notice how the Arab nations responded to this. Obviously, they're not going to respond favorably. They're in favor of Jerusalem being the capital of Palestine and not Israel. And so, there is this battle that still ensues between Ishmael and the descendants of Isaac. And the battle is no coincidence, and most of

us understand that. The world can't really understand it, but we do. The battle is over the City of the King.

And it is fascinating what's happening here on earth has happened in heaven. And you think about the prayer, you know, the Lord's Prayer in Matthew 6:10, "**Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.**" There's another facet to that: the things that have happened in heaven will be mimicked here on earth. There was a battle for Jerusalem in heaven, and the enemy lost that battle. There is a battle here on earth for Jerusalem. The enemy is going to lose the battle, and the heavenly Jerusalem ultimately is going to fall here on this earthly Jerusalem. So, the one who is in bondage, as Paul says, is going to be set free. And so very, very exciting.

But looking at this actually happening, most of us could not even imagine an actual US president having the chutzpah to actually declare *Yerushalayim* the capital of Israel. It is an absolutely incredible privilege to be living in these days and in this country that has made that declaration. Profound.

Evangelicals across the nation, Messianics, and believers alike are rejoicing over this; maybe not the Pope, but the majority of believers are rejoicing in what has happened because they all identify Jerusalem as belonging to Israel. They all identify Bible prophecy, and so the days we are embarking on are so powerful. I want you to think about something in the midst of all this, in this rejoicing, and amid the reality of what just happened this week, which is hard. It's so surreal it's hard to get your arms wrapped around, but what are the implications of this proclamation—what are going to be the implications of the president of the United States virtually declaring *Yerushalayim*, Jerusalem, as the capital of Israel? There are going to be implications.

Israel is already facing them if you've seen what was going on in Hebron and Nablus, places I was just at, which are a little frightening to think about, but there were uprisings already. There's already destabilization happening in Israel; the IDF is busier than it's ever been right now. And so, we see this, but it's going to go much deeper than that.

And here's where I'm going with this. I keep going back to Zechariah 14 because, you know, several years back, when the UN made a real push to divide Jerusalem to have the Palestinians have their side of Jerusalem and Israel to possess the other side of Jerusalem. When they made that push, it really forced me into the Word because Zechariah 14:2 says Jerusalem will be divided. "**...Half of the city shall go into captivity...**" But I always wondered what event would set it all in motion. Because it always seemed like there was a stumbling block, there was this brick wall, if you will, preventing this from happening, and I was always meditating over the last several years: what event would do this?

This week. I believe we have seen the event that will trigger a domino effect, as these uprisings are going to become increasingly intense. And what we may just see is that it gets so intense that Israel may have to respond to this intensity. In the eyes of the world, it may be an overreach and ultimately will lead to the division of Jerusalem, but all of this is the plan of the LORD, and all of this is to bring the nations down to gather against Israel to bring them into judgment. So, we are really living in profound times.

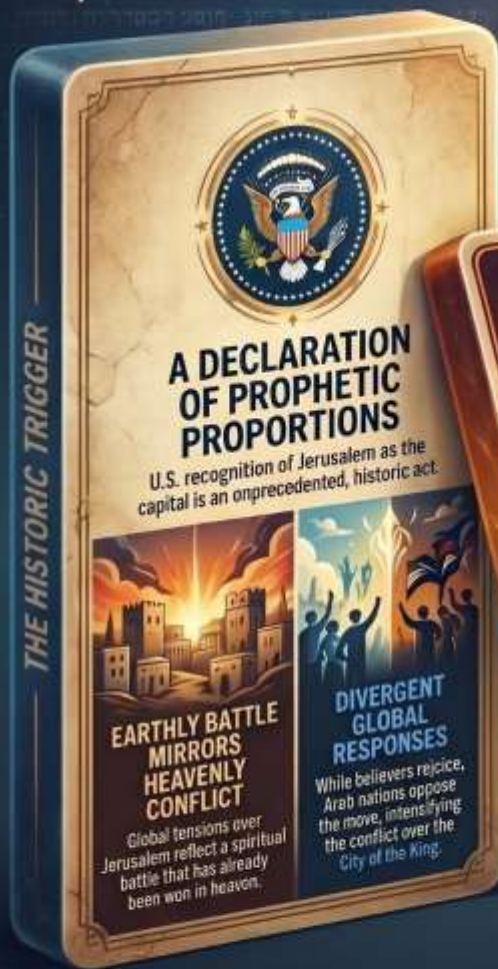
