Relax! God put the wiggles in children; don't feel you have to suppress them in God's house. All are welcome!

Sit toward the front so your little ones can see and hear what's going on. They tire of seeing the backs of others' heads.

Quietly explain the parts of the service and actions of the pastor, ushers, choir, etc. Sing the worship songs, pray, and voice the responses. Children learn to worship by copying you.

If you have to leave the service with your child, feel free to do so, but please come back. As Jesus said, "Let the children come to me."

Remember that the way we welcome children in church directly affects the way they respond to the church, to God, and to one another. Let them know that they are at home in this house of worship.



# Teach Us To Worship Signs

## Call to Worship

God calls His people to gather and worship Him.



## Praise

We gather to praise God with all our being.



## Confession of Sin

Because we are loved by God, we can confess our sins to Him. "Confess" means to admit you are wrong.



## Assurance of Pardon

We know we are forgiven because we are God's people and Jesus died for our sins.



## Prayer

We talk to God through prayer.



## Tithes & Offerings

Everything belongs to the Lord.



## Reading the Word

God speaks to His people through His Word.



## Walking in the Word

God's word teaches His people how to live.



## Sacraments

God gives us signs to proclaim His love for us and seal us as His own.



## Benediction

God sends us with His blessing.
