Opening Question

Looking Back

- What stood out most to you from Sunday's message?
- What did you learn about God's character from Micah 1-2?
- Which of these truths impacted you most? Why?
 - God sees what others ignore.
 - God speaks what others avoid.
 - God gathers what sin scatters.

Digging Into Scripture

Read Micah 1:2-5.

- What does this passage teach us about God's involvement in the world?
- Why is it important that God is not distant or detached from human suffering?

Read Micah 2:1-11.

- Why were the people resistant to Micah's message?
- What are some truths people are tempted to avoid today?
- How can we distinguish conviction from condemnation?

Read Micah 2:12-13.

- What stands out to you about God's promise to gather His people?
- How does this passage point forward to Jesus?

Living It Out

1. Compassion was described as "empathy plus action." What do you think that means practically?
2. Where do you see people in our community who are overlooked, forgotten, or hurting?
3. How can our Life Group better reflect God's heart by seeing, speaking, and gathering?
4. What role does the Holy Spirit play in helping us represent Jesus in the world?
5. What am I overlooking that God sees?

Prayer Time

Invite each person to share:

- One area where they need God to help them listen.
- One person they feel called to move toward this week.

Close by praying that Skyline would be a church that sees what God sees, speaks what God speaks, and gathers who God gathers.
