Opening Question

Who is someone that positively shaped your life through their influence? What made them such an impactful leader?

Looking Back

- What stood out most to you from Sunday's message?
- What was one new insight you gained from Micah 3-4?
- How did the description of God in Exodus 34 help you better understand Micah's message?

Digging Into Scripture

Read Micah 3:1-12.

- What leadership failures does Micah identify?
- Why do you think God uses such graphic language to describe these leaders?
- What does Micah 3 teach us about the dangers of influence used for personal gain?

Read Exodus 34:6-7.

- How do Micah's leaders fail to reflect God's character?
- Why is it possible to carry God's name while forgetting God's heart?
- Have you ever seen this danger in your own life?

Read Micah 3:8.

- What stands out about Micah's description of himself?
- Why is being filled with the Spirit essential for representing God well?
- What qualities of Micah do you most want to emulate?

Read Micah 4:1-8.

- What picture of God's kingdom do you find most encouraging?
- What does flourishing look like under God's leadership?
- How can we help create spaces where people experience that kind of flourishing today?

Living It Out

- Where has God entrusted you with influence right now?
- Who are the people most impacted by your leadership?
- If those people described your influence, would they say they are flourishing because of it? Why or why not?
- What is one practical way you can better represent God's heart this week?
