Opening Question

Looking Back

- What stood out most to you from Sunday's message?
- What part of Micah 6:1-8 challenged you the most?
- What did you learn about God's character from this passage?

Digging Into Scripture

Read Micah 6:1-5

- Why does God begin by reminding Israel of what He has done for them?
- What does this passage teach us about God's faithfulness?
- Why is remembering God's character so important?

Read Micah 6:6-7

- What assumptions are the people making about God?
- How do we sometimes treat faith like a transaction?
- What are some modern examples of religious performance?

Read Micah 6:8

- What does it mean to "act justly"?
- What stood out to you about the meaning of hesed (faithful love)?
- Why do you think Micah says to "love" mercy?
- What does it practically look like to walk humbly with God?

Living It Out

- Where is God inviting you to participate in His work of justice?
- Who in your life needs to experience faithful love from you this week?
- What is one area where you need to stop trying to be in control and walk more humbly with God?
- If someone observed your life this week, what would they learn about God's character?
