Life Group Study Questions

- 1) What words or phrases does Paul use to describe fools? Examine those and think of stories from the Bible that show us how these descriptions are true for all mankind since the Fall.
 - Example: In Exodus, Pharaoh is confronted with horrific plagues and staunchly refuses to give God the honor he is due
- 2) What are the short term and long term consequences for those who suppress the truth of God and refuse to honor him?
- 3) If the hearts of unbelievers are darkened, list some principles that help us witness to them about the Light.
- 4) Define idolatry (vs. 23). Where do you find yourself spending time, energy and capital that is ultimately for building your kingdom and not God's kingdom?
 - Example: You desire more money just to spend it on your own pleasures (James 4:3)
- 5) Which verses of scripture do you turn to regularly to remind yourself of the awesome work God has done? How do you keep the truth of God fixed in your mind rather than getting lost amidst all other things we hear and read?
