AGENDA

CALL TO ORDER

The Meeting was called to order by Chair, Judge Perry Newcom, at 10:12 AM (CST).

ROLL CALL

Angela Herndon conducted the roll call and a quorum was established.

At Large Member Approval

Chair Judge Perry Newcom announced that there were three (3) people that had been nominated for appointment as At-Large Members to the RTC. The nominees included:

John Oliphant, Trigg County
Matt Grimes, Crittenden County

Judge Jack Whitfield made the motion to approve the At Large Members as presented. The motion was seconded by Mayor Bill Hesser. All Ayes. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Judge Perry Newcom asked everyone to review the minutes from the April 26th, 2023 of the RTC that were included in the packet. Judge Jaime Green made the motion to approve the minutes as presented. The motion was seconded by Mayor Jackie Oliver. All Ayes. Motion carried.

DISTRICT 1 HIGHWAY PROJECT UPDATE

Kyle Poat Introduced Austin Hart to provide the KYTC District 1 Update.

Livingston County:

An alternate to extend off the Ledbetter Bridge at the US 60 project has been identified. They hope to start purchasing right-of-way in the Spring of 2024.

They are finishing up the demolition of the Smithland Bridge. They hope to drop that bridge in October. The demolition crew mobilized to the project site this week.

Crittenden County:

Several Bridge projects including the Kentucky Bridge project which they hope to get started in the Fall of 2023 with construction beginning in the Spring of 2024. They are finishing up the Cave-In-Rock Study which they hope will be finished by February 2024.

Lyon and Caldwell Counties

They are moving forward with finishing the US 641 Corridor that was started in Crittenden County. They have a preferred alternative identified there and anticipate purchasing right-of-way beginning in the Spring of 2024.

Trigg County

Finishing up punch list items on the I-24 Project that is wrapping up. Several Bridge projects in Trigg County as well. Right-of-way plans completed and are almost finished with final plans for the intersection at KY139/KY124 northeast of Cadiz. They were hoping to have a November/December Letting but as only 3 of the 7 parcels are moving forward in the condemnation phase a delay is anticipated. It is anticipated there will be sidewalks associated with the project due to the proximity to the new Dollar General store location.

DISTRICT 2 HIGHWAY PROJECT UPDATE

The update was provided by Deneatra Henderson from KYTC District 2. The I-169 interstate upgrades are underway. The contract has been let. In Caldwell County, the upgrades in lighting following the tornado damage were turned on recently.

DISTRICT 3 HIGHWAY PROJECT UPDATE

Mr. Joseph Plunk announced that in Todd County the main project was the US 79 Widening and they were making great progress. There is right-of-way being purchased along the planned project. The BUILD Grant funds 3.5 out of 5 bridges complete. The projects should be substantially complete by November 30, 2023.

SHIFT SCORING RESULTS

Mrs. Angela Herndon provided an overview of the SHIFT Scoring results that had been received from KYTC. A spreadsheet was provided that showed each county with their pre-boost scores, any boost points that were added by the District, and the boost points that were added by the CUAMPO. The sorting showed the highest scoring projects.

BOOST ALLOCATION FORMULA

Mrs. Angela Herndon provided an overview of how the boost points were allocated to each county.

BOOST POINT SELECTION

Mrs. Angela Herndon allowed each of the counties to confer within their groups and review the project scores. The group recessed for 28 minutes to confer with their county representatives.

- Caldwell County selected IP20210126
- Crittenden County selected 01-187.60
- Christian County selected 02-8953.00, 02-899.00, 02-80250.10, IP202110077, and IP20100034
- Hopkins County selected 02-804.40, IP20070078, and 02-384.00
- Livingston County selected 01-330.00
- Lyon County selected 01-187.50
- Muhlenberg County selected 02-802.01 and 02-8802.00
- Todd County selected 03-80001.00
- Trigg County selected IP20230106

Due to a rounding error in the boost allocation formula there was an extra project to be boosted. Mayor Greg Greene to allocate the extra project to Trigg County for selection. The motion was seconded by Judge Jerry Gilliam. All Ayes. Motion Carried.

Trigg County selected project 01-147.00.

The motion to accept the projects for boosting as proposed was made by Judge Jack Whitfield and seconded by Judge Jaime Smith. All Ayes. Motion Carried.

SHIFT SCHEDULE

Mrs. Angela Herndon went over the next steps and indicated that any future schedule updates would be communicated with the committee. She also noted the next regularly scheduled meeting would be October 25, 2023 and asked for everyone to check their schedules for conflicts.
