CALL TO ORDER:

RTC BYLAWS

Mrs. Herndon reviewed the committee bylaws highlighting the composition of the membership, terms of office, and meeting schedule. She asked if there were any changes or additions that needed to be made to the bylaws. A motion was made by Mayor Arthur Greene to adopt the bylaws. The motion was seconded by Judge Jack Whitfield. The motion passed unanimously.

REGIONAL GOALS & OBJECTIVES

Mrs. Herndon reviewed the Regional Goals and Objectives with the Committee and highlighted several current projects that conformed with the goals and objectives. She encouraged an in-depth review of the Goals & Objectives at a future meeting to ensure that the document included current projects such as the I-569 designation on the Western Kentucky Parkway, the completion of I-169 corridor improvements, improvements that need to be made to I-24 to improve capacity, and improvements that need to be made to the KY115 Interchange on I-24.

Mrs. Herndon reviewed the grant applications that have been submitted as a result of the Bi-Partisan Infrastructure Law and the upcoming due dates for several additional grant opportunities.
