Peace Memorial Presbyterian Church (110 S. Fort Harrison Avenue) is located at the NW corner of Fort Harrison Avenue and Pierce Street in downtown Clearwater. Use the QR Code above to view a downtown map. The City Parking Map is updated in real time.

During peak traffic times, you may wish to use Myrtle Avenue and access the church by way of Pierce or Park Streets.

Accessibility | Complimentary Parking

- Handicap Parking is available in the Pinellas County Utility Building Lot (14 S. Fort Harrison Avenue).
- Through the gated McGeachy Memorial Garden between the Sanctuary and Roebling Buildings is **ramp access**.

On Sundays, ample free parking is available on the street and in nearby lots (See QR Code):

- Directly across Fort Harrison Avenue in front of the Church (east side) with lot entrances via Pierce and Park Streets;
- Directly north of the Church in the Pinellas County Utilities Building Lot.

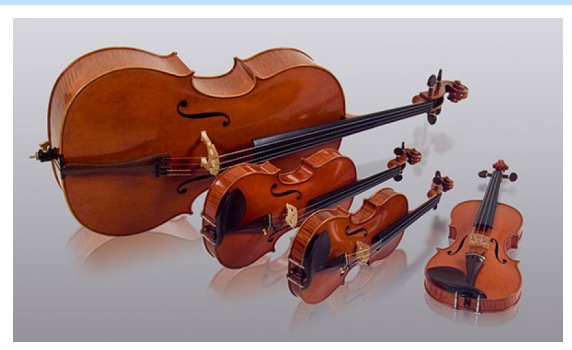
October – March
