

CAMP “I AM” Junior (for children who have *completed* the 1st - 3rd grades)

CAMP “I AM” is a children’s camp designed to provide our youth with the opportunities to grow physically, mentally, socially, and (most importantly) spiritually. We have developed a strong program that challenges all campers to grow in these key areas. Whether interacting with others during camp-wide activities, or exploring the Bible in cabin devotion, Bible study, and worship, Camp “I AM” Junior promises to impact every camper who attends. SCHEDULE: Many activities will be packed into this twenty-two-hour adventure, and it will look something like the following:

SIGN-IN (3:30-4:30 p.m.) > Supper > Worship > Planned Activity > Campfire/fellowship > Bed
Morning devotional > Breakfast > Bible Study > Water fun > Lunch > Pack up & go home (1-1:30 p.m.)

CAMP-WIDE ACTIVITIES: What would camp be like without awesome, energetic, and creative camp-wide events? There will be an organized camp-wide activity after Worship, before the campfire. Water activities will be offered to all campers in the morning after Bible study. We also have several activities on the spiritual side of camp such as: Devotions, Worship, Bible study, and Testimonies.

This year’s theme is *The Storyteller: Life-Changing Parables of Jesus*; our Bible Study, Worship and Devotion will reflect parables of Jesus Christ shared in the Gospels.

** Prior to camp, each registered camper will receive a schedule, medical release form, and camp handbook. These will be accessible online or mailed out after early registration has ended. Early registration is March 1st – April 30th, and the cost is \$25 per camper. Final registration is May 1st – June 30th, and the cost goes up to \$30. After June 30th, names will be put on a waiting list, and if someone cancels, you will be called. Fees can be paid online or mailed in; the cost includes a camp tee shirt, all snacks, meals and activities. Please **do not send any extra money** with your child; he/she will not need it!
