

## CAMP “I AM” Senior (for children who have *completed* the 4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> grades)

CAMP “I AM” is a children’s camp designed to provide our youth with the opportunities to grow physically, mentally, socially, and (most importantly) spiritually. We have developed a strong program that challenges all campers to grow in these key areas. Whether progressing through our skill classes, interacting with others during camp-wide activities, or exploring the Bible in cabin devotions, Bible study, and worship, Camp “I AM” Senior promises to impact every camper who attends. This year’s unforgettable adventure will take place **July 20<sup>th</sup> - 24<sup>th</sup>** at its **NEW LOCATION**—Fostering Bulloch’s 7<sup>th</sup> Mile Farm (7200 GA Hwy. 46, Statesboro, GA 30458).

**SKILL PROGRAMS:** While at camp each camper can choose up to eight different skill classes to attend. [This does not mean that campers will get all of his/her choices. We just want to give ample opportunities for each camper to participate in activities that meet his/her interests.] The classes will last for about an hour. During these sessions, campers will be coached and challenged to progress in the activity being taught. Whether athletically gifted or artistically inclined, our wide variety of skill offerings promises to provide something for everyone. The following is a list of the skill classes we plan to offer:

Prior to camp, each registered camper will receive a medical release form and camp handbook with schedules. These will be accessible online or mailed out after early registration has ended. Early registration is March 1<sup>st</sup> – April 30<sup>th</sup>, and the cost is \$150 per camper. Final registration is May 1<sup>st</sup> – June 30<sup>th</sup>, and the cost goes up to \$175. After this, names will be put on a waiting list, and if someone cancels, you will be called. Fees can be paid online or mailed in; the cost includes a camp T-shirt, all snacks, meals and activities. Please **do not send any extra money** with your child; he/she will not need it!
