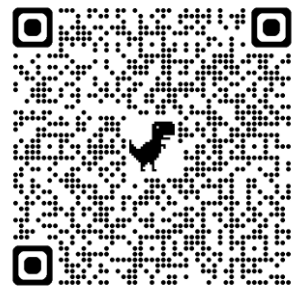

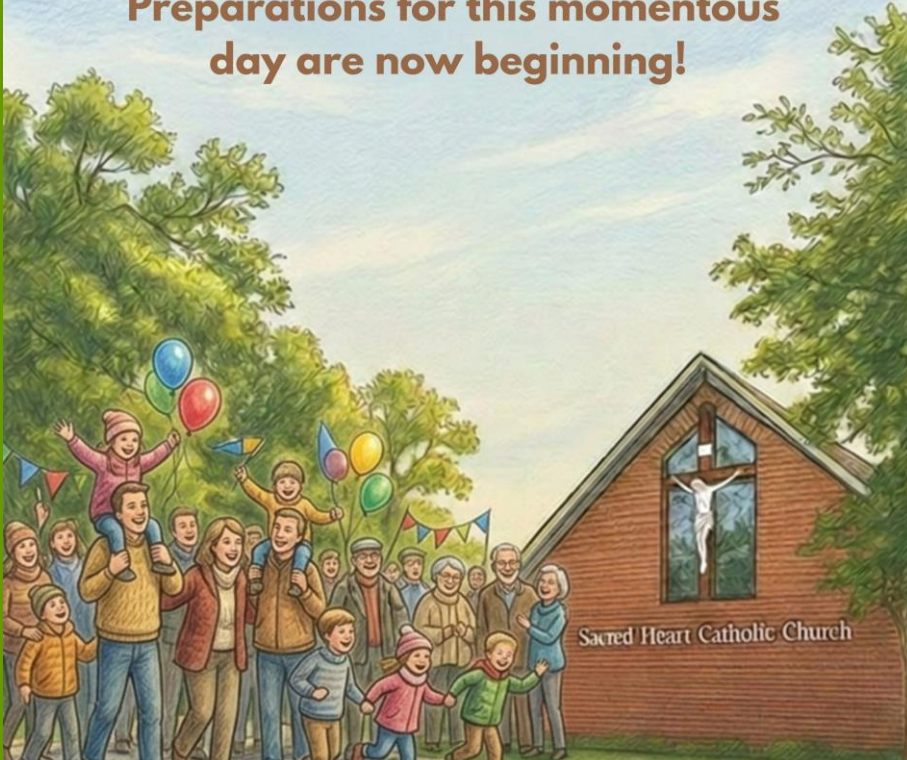

Group Captain Leonard Cheshire

One of the main driving forces behind the original fundraising efforts to build our Church here in Bordon, was a former Parishioner: Grp. Capt. Leonard Cheshire.

There is a 'cause' open for Leonard's Beatification. This is a multi-stepped investigation by the Church (opened by a bishop with Vatican approval) for an individual to ultimately be declared a Saint.

Leonard's cause is currently in what is known as the 'Discovery Stage' or 'Diocesan Stage' which entails gathering information and personal testimonies, promoting prayer and documenting miracles attributed to his intercession.

During Mass on Friday, Father John reminded us of this cause and exhorted the parish to begin to foster a prayerful devotion to Leonard Cheshire.

We hope to spread this devotion beyond the parish, and we would like to produce prayer cards and other resources to be shared across the diocese and beyond.

We will also have an image of Leonard placed in the church as part of our 40th Anniversary preparations, acknowledging the part he played in helping our Parish Church to materialise here in Bordon.

What an amazing privilege it would be for us to have a former parishioner of ours to be declared a saint! Someone in God's company who can intercede on our behalf!

Family learning from the Catechism:

This weekend we hear Jesus call the 12 Apostles. Here is what the catechism says about being 'apostolic':

863 The whole Church is apostolic, in that she remains, through the successors of St. Peter and the other apostles, in communion of faith and life with her origin: and in that she is "sent out" into the whole world. All members of the Church share in this mission, though in various ways. "The Christian vocation is, of its nature, a vocation to the apostolate as well." Indeed, we call an apostolate "every activity of the Mystical Body" that aims "to spread the Kingdom of Christ over all the earth."

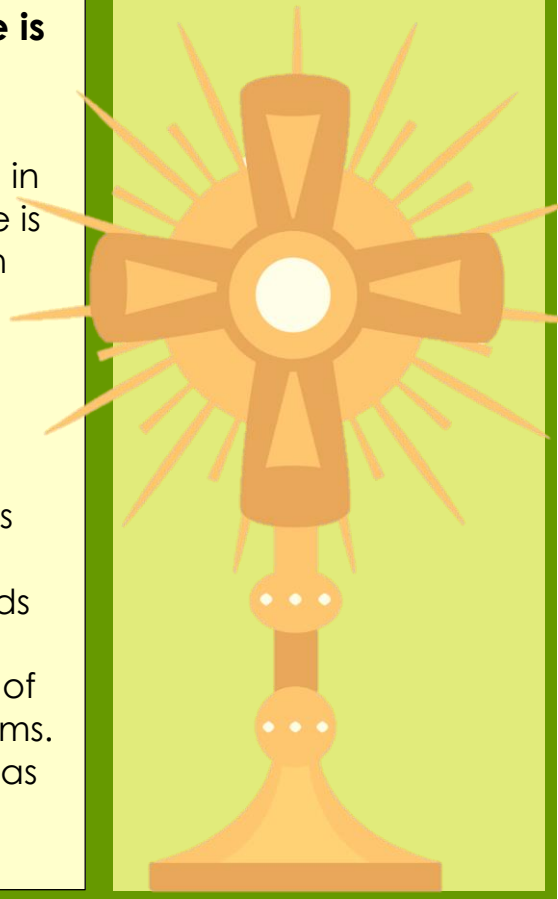
864 "Christ, sent by the Father, is the source of the Church's whole apostolate"; thus the fruitfulness of apostolate for ordained ministers as well as for lay people clearly depends on their vital union with Christ. In keeping with their vocations, the demands of the times and the various gifts of the Holy Spirit, the apostolate assumes the most varied forms. But charity, drawn from the Eucharist above all, is always "as it were, the soul of the whole apostolate."
