



Get behind me Satan!

Last weekend we heard Jesus say to St Peter that whatever he binds on earth shall be bound in Heaven and whatever he looses on earth shall be loosed in Heaven.

This week Jesus says to the same St Peter: 'Get behind me, Satan! You are a hindrance to me'.

How can we balance these two very different statements?

After Jesus rebukes St Peter He says: For you are not setting your mind on the things of God, but on the things of man.'

Here Jesus clarifies for us that whilst St Peter has the authority to bind and to loose, he must do so in accordance with what God requires, not what man wants.

St Peter and His successors cannot change what Jesus taught, said or did, they cannot change what has been revealed. Their authority to bind and loose comes from the Lord who is the builder, building His church.

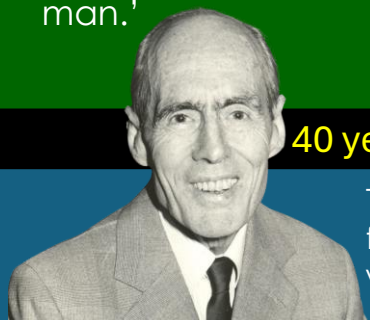
The Pope doesn't have the authority to change what Jesus has commanded, instead he is the ultimate protector and defender, he must safeguard the deposit of faith.

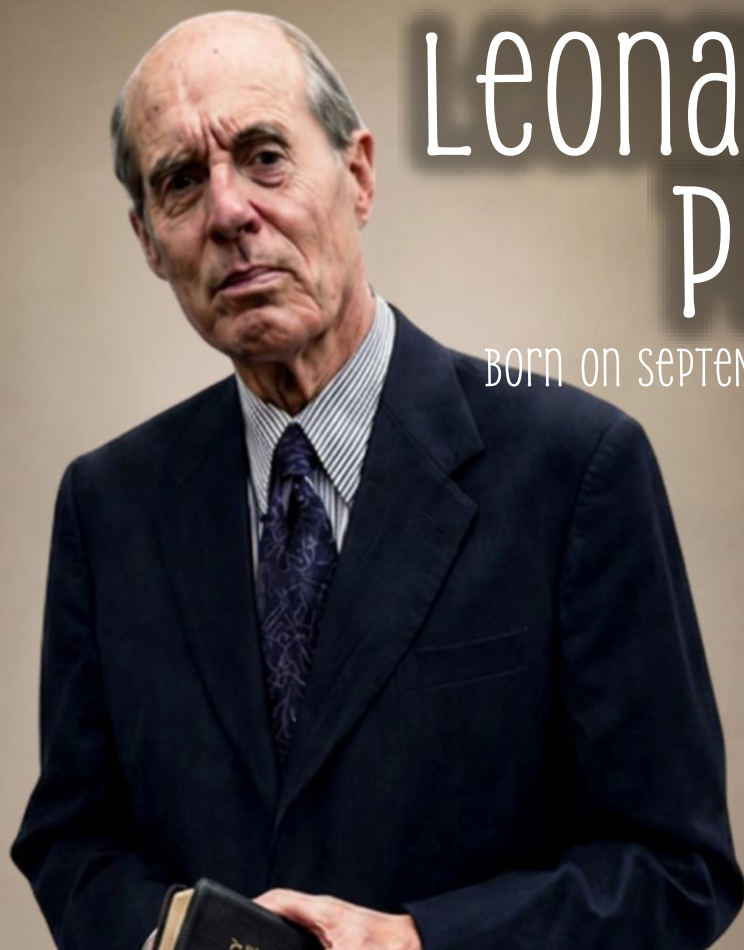

Seeking the Intercession of Leonard Cheshire

Next Monday, 7th September, is Leonard Cheshire's birthday. He would have been 109 years old.

We will begin to increase our efforts of promoting his cause for Sainthood aiming for a full 12 months promotion by his **110th birthday** in 2027.

In the next 12 months we hope to:

- Familiarise ourselves (as a parish) with Leonard's life and work
- Produce materials encouraging prayer and devotion
- Form a prayer group to support our work
- Promote Leonard's cause across the Diocese (and beyond!)

It would be good if we could form a small team to dedicate themselves to this project.

If you would like to be part of this team, please do speak to Father. We hope to include people from within and outside of the parish to help, so if you know of anyone who may be interested, please also direct them to Father.

The prayer opposite will be the official prayer we will ask people to use to seek Leonard's intercession for them or for an intention dear to them.

We will mark the beginning of this 12-month project at the 10am Mass on Monday 7th September.

Family learning from the Catechism:

This weekend Jesus says that we must do three things: deny the self, take up the Cross and follow Him. The Catechism reminds us of what this means:

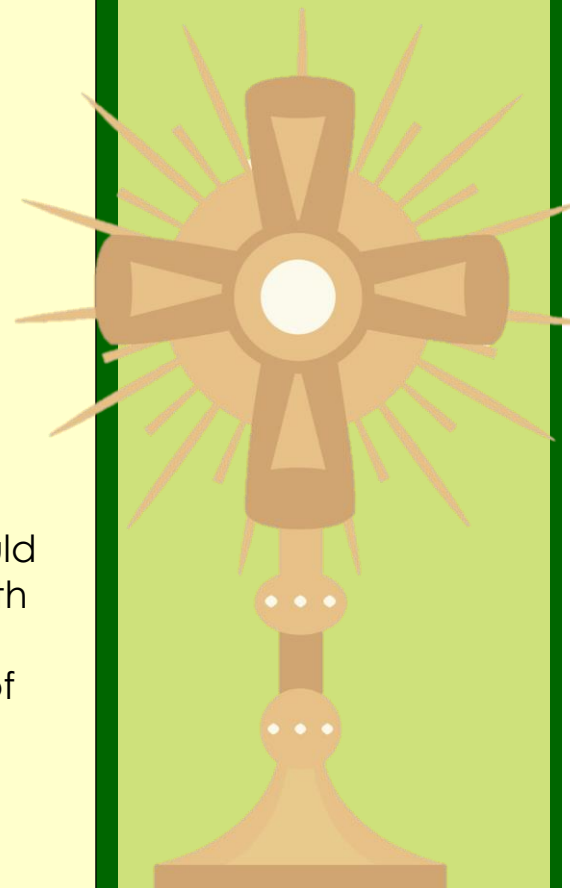
618 The cross is the unique sacrifice of Christ, the "one mediator between God and men". But because in his incarnate divine person he has in some way united himself to every man, "the possibility of being made partners, in a way known to God, in the paschal mystery" is offered to all men. He calls his disciples to "take up their cross and follow him", for "Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example so that we should follow in his steps." In fact Jesus desires to associate with his redeeming sacrifice those who were to be its first beneficiaries. This is achieved supremely in the case of his mother, who was associated more intimately than any other person in the mystery of his redemptive suffering.
