



## The Most Blessed Trinity



Last weekend The Third Person of the Blessed Trinity was revealed to us – God the Holy Spirit.

Today we celebrate our coming to full knowledge of God – who is One and Three.

Three Persons who make one God. The diagram above helps us to see that the Three Persons are distinct and each one of them is God.

One is not more God than the other – they are equal. Today's Preface at Mass explains this to us:

It is truly right and just, our duty and our salvation, always and everywhere to give you thanks, Lord, holy Father, almighty and eternal God.

For with your Only Begotten Son and the Holy Spirit you are one God, one Lord: **not in the unity of a single person**, but in a Trinity of one substance.

For what you have revealed to us of your glory we believe equally of your Son and of the Holy Spirit, so that, in the confessing of the true and eternal Godhead, you might be adored in what is proper to each Person, their unity in substance, **and their equality in majesty.**

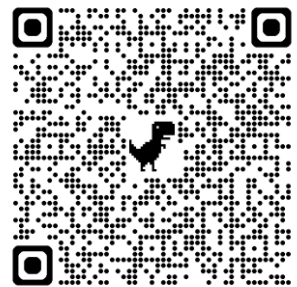

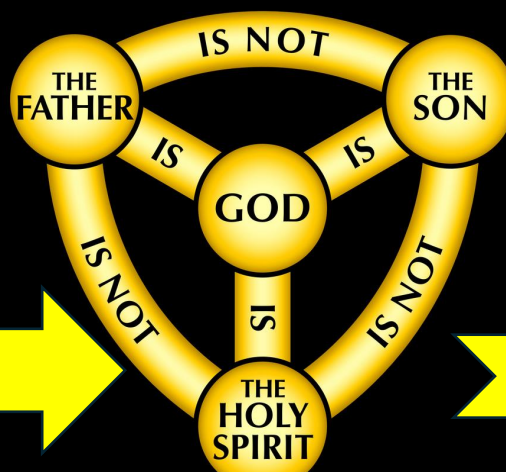

On the Day of Pentecost, the fullness of God was revealed. God is one who is made up of Three Persons.




**Trinity**

**Family learning from the Catechism:**

**This weekend we celebrate Trinity Sunday. What does the Catechism say about the Blessed Trinity?**

**253** *The Trinity is One.* We do not confess three Gods, but one God in three persons, the "consubstantial Trinity". The divine persons do not share the one divinity among themselves but each of them is God whole and entire: "The Father is that which the Son is, the Son that which the Father is, the Father and the Son that which the Holy Spirit is, i.e. by nature one God." In the words of the Fourth Lateran Council (1215), "Each of the persons is that supreme reality, viz., the divine substance, essence or nature."

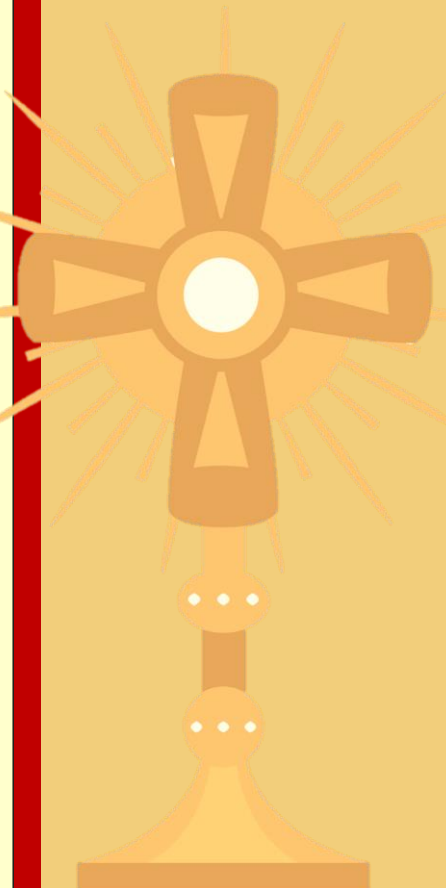
**254** *The divine persons are really distinct from one another.* "God is one but not solitary." "Father", "Son", "Holy Spirit" are not simply names designating modalities of the divine being, for they are really distinct from one another: "He is not the Father who is the Son, nor is the Son he who is the Father, nor is the Holy Spirit he who is the Father or the Son." They are distinct from one another in their relations of origin: "It is the Father who generates, the Son who is begotten, and the Holy Spirit who proceeds." The divine Unity is Triune.
