



True God and True Man



On the First Sunday of Lent Jesus went into the Wilderness with a mission – to be tempted.

We thought about His hunger and how the Devil wanted to tempt Him. This makes us think about how Jesus is **true Man**.

Then last weekend on the Second Sunday of Lent we thought about how St Peter reduced Jesus to the same status as Moses and Elijah and so God the Father shouted from Heaven – THIS IS MY SON LISTEN TO HIM, and so we thought about the Lord's Divinity; how He is, was and always will be **true God**.

Today we notice both the Lord's Humanity and Divinity as He encounters the Samaritan woman at the well.

He is thirsty, as man, but He could tell the woman 'everything she ever did' as God.

The parallels with human and divine, natural and supernatural, the seen and unseen continues in the conversation the Lord has with her as they discuss food and drink – physical thirst and hunger alongside spiritual thirst and hunger.

Lent is a time for us to discipline the body allowing the soul to take charge.





Preparing for Holy Week: Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion



Each week we will take a look at one of the days of Holy Week – the holiest week of the year for Catholics.

Today we begin with Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord.

On Palm Sunday we begin Holy Mass by gathering outside of the Church. Just as Jesus processed into Jerusalem, we process too.

Before the procession begins palm branches are blessed, and the palm branch is symbolic.....

As Jesus rode into Jerusalem in the way the Prophets foretold, the people were so happy and excited that they tore branches from the trees and spread cloaks on the ground for Jesus to ride upon as a sign of honour.

'Hosannah Son of David! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord' they cried, welcoming Him.

But, by Friday those cries of 'hosannah' become cries of 'crucify – give us Barabbas', so to remind us of how quickly we are to shout 'hosanna' one day and 'crucify' the next we take the palm branch home and we turn it into a Cross.

We don't begin with a cross, otherwise we miss the whole point – the people were not waving crosses at Jesus when He arrived!

Turning our own branch into a cross is a prayerful thing to do. We can think about how we treat God, the ways we expect Him to do as we tell Him and how annoyed we get when we do not get our own way.

Then, next year, we return that palm cross and it is burned. The ashes of the palm branches become the ash we receive on Ash Wednesday.

So please arrive a few minutes earlier than usual on Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord which is Sunday 29th March this year.

569 Jesus went up to Jerusalem voluntarily, knowing well that there he would die a violent death because of the opposition of sinners.


