

Our worship begins with a scriptural call for God's people to worship. In this way, our gathered worship is a conversation initiated by God between himself and his people.

† CALL TO WORSHIP

Psalm 96:1-6

Leader: Oh sing to the LORD a new song; sing to the LORD, all the earth! Sing to the LORD, bless his name;

People: Tell of his salvation from day to day. Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous works among all the peoples!

Leader: For great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised; he is to be feared above all gods. For all the gods of the peoples are worthless idols, but the LORD made the heavens.

All: Splendor and majesty are before him; strength and beauty are in his sanctuary.

† CONFESSION OF FAITH

Second Helvetic Confession, Ch 14, Sec. 2

Leader: Let us declare together what we believe the Scriptures teach: What Is repentance?

We are a Confessional Church. We choose to stand shoulder to shoulder with those saints who have gone before us. We embrace the timeless doctrinal truths of the Gospel

God Cleanses us Within the context of our relationship with God, we are invited in safety, not shame, to consider our sins. God loves us in spite of our sins. We rehearse this truth each week by confessing our sins corporately and leaning into his renewal, restoration, and cleansing.

The scripture that follows our confession assures us of God's forgiveness, grace and pardon. This is the good news.

All: By repentance we understand the change of the mind in a sinful man stirred up by the preaching of the Gospel through the Holy Spirit, and received by a true faith: by which a sinful man does acknowledge his natural corruption, and all his sins, seeing them convinced by the Word of God, and is heartily grieved for them; and does not only bewail and freely confess them before God with shame, but also loathe and abhor them with indignation, thinking seriously of present amendment, and of a continual care of innocency and virtue, wherein to exercise himself holily all the rest of his life.

CONFESSION OF SIN

Leader: Let us now confess our sins to our Father in heaven.
All: Father, you are a God of great compassion. In Christ, you did not disdain the company of sinners but welcomed them with love. Oh, that we showed the compassion and love that you do. We confess that instead of compassion, we have been self-absorbed. Instead of mercy, we have been judgmental and self-righteous. Instead of going forth in faith, we have retreated in fear and greed. Instead of occupying ourselves with making the gospel known to others, we have been consumed with vanity. Our sins are great, and our hearts are cold. Please forgive us. Please restore unto us the joy of thy salvation and ignite a holy compassion in us. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.
