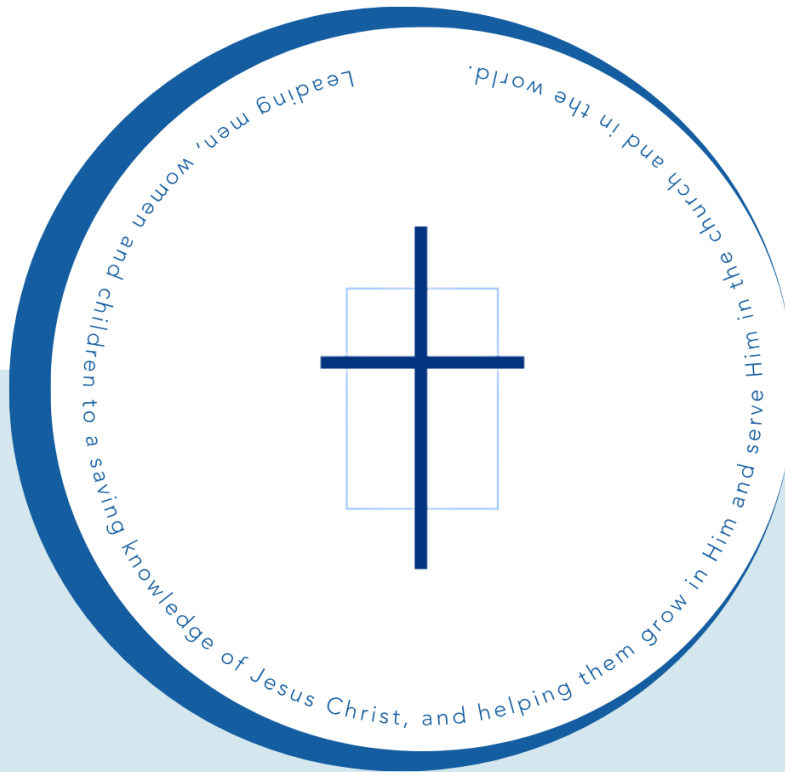

† CONFESSION OF FAITH The Canons of Dort, 2nd Head of Doctrine, Art. 5

Leader Let us declare together what we believe: What do you believe about the promise of the gospel?

All: Moreover, the promise of the gospel is, that whosoever believeth in Christ crucified, shall not perish, but have everlasting life. This promise, together with the command to repent and believe, ought to be declared and published to all nations, and to all persons promiscuously and without distinction, to whom God out of His good pleasure sends the gospel.

GOD CLEANSSES US

Within the context of our relationship with God, we are invited in safety, not shame, to consider our sins. God loves us in spite of our sins. We rehearse this truth each week by confessing our sins corporately and leaning into his renewal, restoration, and cleansing.

CONFESSION OF SIN Based on Rom. 12:11; Ecc. 11:4; Rev. 2:4; Heb. 3:13; Mt. 22:37

Leader: Let us now confess our sins together before our Lord:

All: Lord Jesus, as the head of the church, we acknowledge that we have been slothful in zeal, not fervent in spirit, serving the Lord. We have too often observed the wind, and have not sown, and regarded the clouds, and have not reaped. Our first love for you has been lacking. At the bottom of this sin, we see an evil, unbelieving heart, leading us to fall away from the living God. Forgive us, Lord. We repent of this sin of lukewarmness. May we love you with all of our heart, soul, and mind. May we serve you best of all. In your name, Amen.
