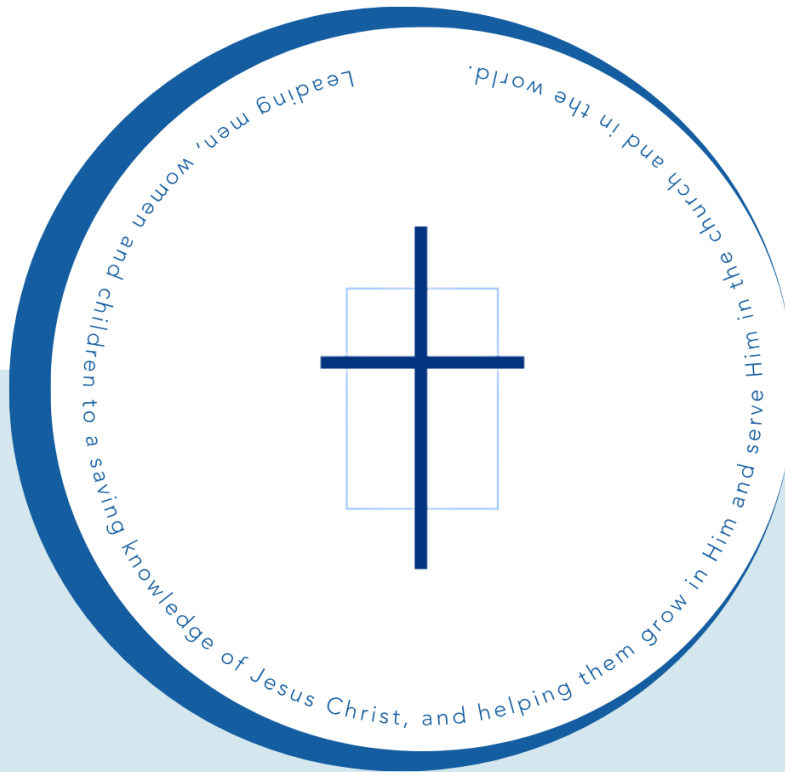

† CONFESSION OF FAITH Westminster Shorter Catechism, Q. No. 87

Leader: Let us declare together what we believe the Scriptures teach: What is repentance unto life?

All: Repentance unto life is a saving grace, whereby a sinner, out of a true sense of his sin, and apprehension of the mercy of God in Christ, doth, with grief and hatred of his sin, turn from it unto God, with full purpose of, and endeavor after, new obedience.

GOD CLEANSSES US
Within the context of our relationship with God, we are invited in safety, not shame, to consider our sins. God loves us in spite of our sins. We rehearse this truth each week by confessing our sins corporately and leaning into his renewal, restoration, and cleansing.

CONFESSION OF SIN.....Ezekiel 33:11

Leader: “As I live, declares the Lord GOD, I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked, but that the wicked turn from his way and live.”

Let us now confess our sins before our God:

All: Our Father in heaven, we are never more in need of the gospel than right now. Even though we may have been Christians for decades, the remaining sin continues to raise its ugly head and display its power to hoodwink us into believing we must obey its commands. The good we would do, we do not, and the evil we would shun, we do. Sometimes it feels that for every step forward we make in godliness, we take two steps backward. We confess our sins to you—sins of pride, arrogance, discourtesy, dishonesty, selfishness, disloyalty, disrespect, and so much more. May our grief produce a repentance that leads to salvation without regret. In Christ’s name. Amen.¹
