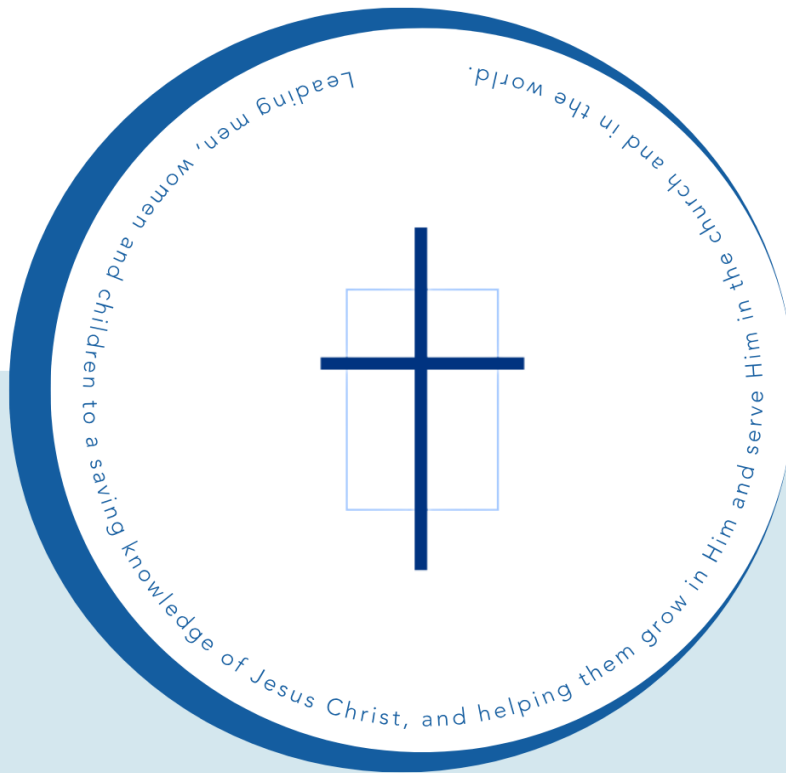

† **CONFESSION OF FAITH** Westminster Confession of Faith, Ch XVI, Sec 6

Leader: Let us declare together what we believe the Scriptures teach: Since none of our good works contribute to our salvation, how does God view the works and sacrifices of His children?

All: Notwithstanding, the persons of believers being accepted through Christ, their good works also are accepted in Him; not as though they were in this life wholly undeserving of blame and punishment in God's sight; but that He, looking on them in His Son, is pleased to accept and reward that which is sincere, although accompanied with many weaknesses and imperfections.

GOD CLEANSSES US

Within the context of our relationship with God, we are invited in safety, not shame, to consider our sins. God loves us in spite of our sins. We rehearse this truth each week by confessing our sins corporately and leaning into his renewal, restoration, and cleansing.

The scripture that follows our confession assures us of God's forgiveness, grace and pardon. This is the good news.

CONFESSION OF SIN

Leader: Let us confess together our sins before our holy and merciful God:
All: O God, whose nature it is to be generous, forgive us for our self-centered living and spending; forgive those who blame you for not providing them with more. You tell us that we cannot serve both God and money. We confess that our hearts often love and serve our wealth and our fears, more than we love and serve you with our wealth. We acknowledge that love of money is a root of all kinds of evils. Search our hearts, O Lord. Forgive us and free us from the idolatry of wealth, and the fear of poverty, that we might imitate your abundant generosity. We ask all these things, in Christ's name. Amen.
