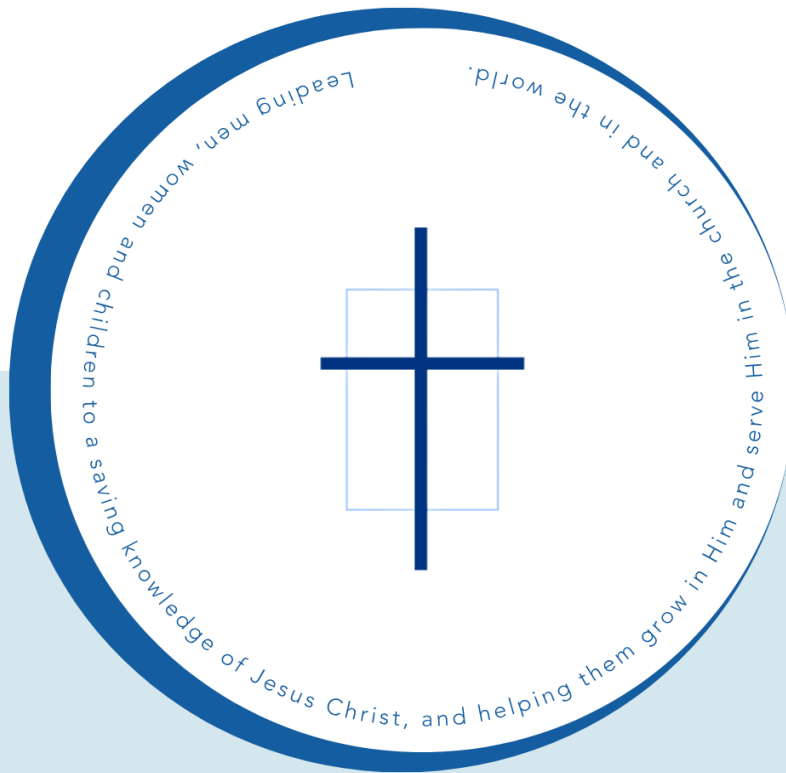

† CONFESSION OF FAITH

The Heidelberg Catechism, Q's. No. 94 & 95

Leader: Let us declare together what we believe: What does the Lord require in the first commandment?

All: That I, not wanting to endanger my very salvation, avoid and shun all idolatry, magic, superstitious rites, and prayer to saints or other creatures. That I sincerely acknowledge the only true God, trust him alone, look to him for every good thing humbly and patiently, love him, fear him, and honor him with all my heart. In short, that I give up anything rather than go against his will in any way.

Leader: What is idolatry?

All: Idolatry is having or inventing something in which one trusts in place of or alongside of the only true God, who has revealed himself in his Word.

CONFESSION OF SIN

Leader: Let us now together confess our sins before the One True God:

All: Heavenly Father, when you gave Moses the Ten Commandments, the very first one warned us about idolatry: 'You shall have no other gods but me.' But no sooner was the Law given than Aaron threw some gold into the furnace and out popped (in his words) a golden calf! And we have been mimicking that ever since. One Reformer wrote that 'man's mind is a perpetual factory of idols.' Father, we would remind ourselves that an idol is anything to which we give more attention than you. Teach us how to destroy them. Grant us courage to oppose them. Give us resolve to seek you and your kingdom first every day, in every way, for Jesus' sake. Amen.¹
