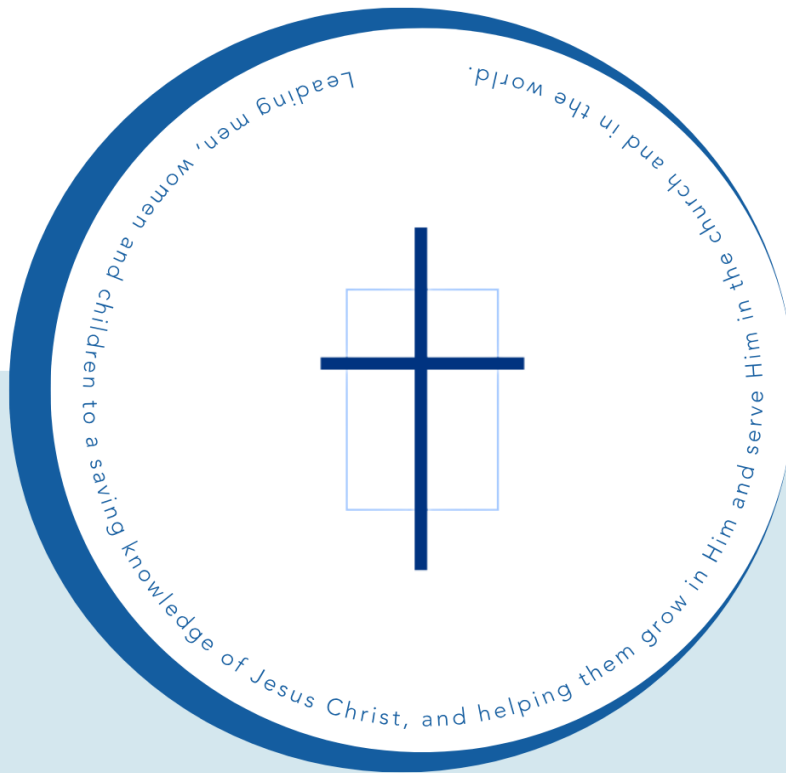

† **CONFESSION OF FAITH** Westminster Shorter Catechism, Q. No. 20

CONFESSION OF SIN

Leader: Let us now confess our sins together before our Lord. Lord, you said, ‘If you love me, you will obey what I command.

People: Forgive us our lukewarm love and our disobedience.

Leader: Lord, you said, ‘You may ask for anything in my name.’

People: Forgive us when we think we need to solve our own problems.

Leader: Lord, you said, ‘Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.’

People: We confess that our lives are often consumed by worry and anxiety.

Leader: Lord, you said, ‘If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit.’

People: Forgive us our barren lives, Lord.

Leader: Lord, you said, ‘You must testify, for you have been with me.’

People: We confess, Lord, that we have been too often silent.

Leader: Lord, you said, ‘Love each other as I have loved you.’

All: In this and in so many other ways, we confess our failures and shortcomings and sins. In Christ’s name. Amen.¹

Matthew 9:35-38

Title: “Learning to Love the Lost as Jesus Loves the Lost”
