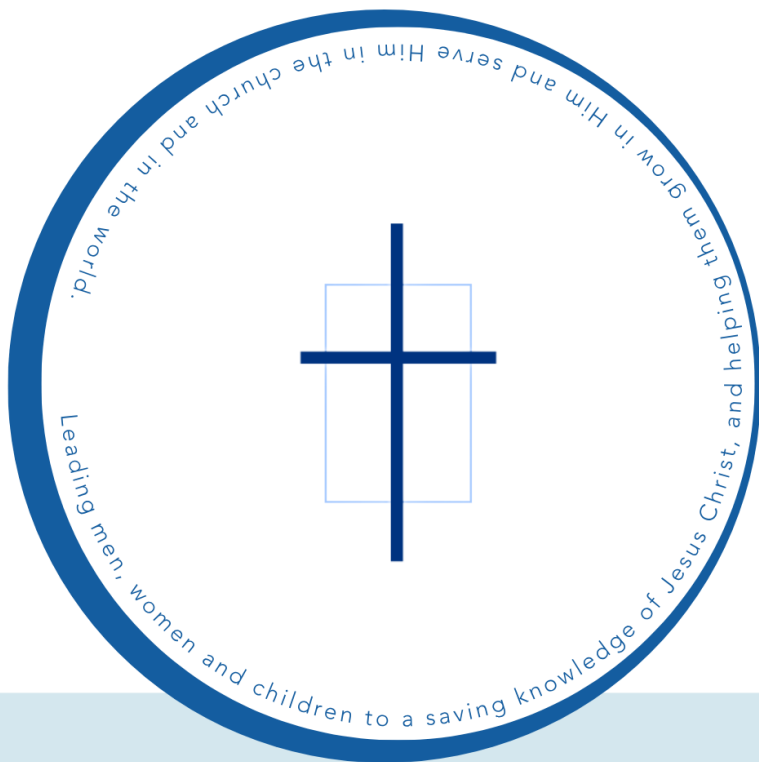

† **CONFESSION OF FAITH** Westminster Shorter Catechism, Q. No. 73-75

Leader: Let us declare together what we believe the Scriptures teach:
Which is the eighth commandment?

All: The eighth commandment is, Thou shalt not steal.

Leader: What is required in the eighth commandment?

All: The eighth commandment requireth the lawful procuring and
furthering of the wealth and outward estate of ourselves and others.

Leader: What is forbidden in the eighth commandment?

All: The eighth commandment forbiddeth whatsoever doth, or may,
unjustly hinder our own, or our neighbor's, wealth or outward estate.

CONFESSION OF SIN Luke 12:15, 16:15

Leader: Let us now together confess our sins before the Lord:

All: Lord Jesus, you once said, 'Take care, and be on your guard against
all covetousness, for one's life does not consist in the abundance of his
possessions,' and you told those who were lovers of money, 'God knows
your hearts. For what is exalted among men is an abomination in the
sight of God.' We confess to you our covetousness, and our coddling
what is exalted among men. We confess to you that there have been times
when we have been stingy and cramped, skimpy and miserly. We who
have received such abundant love and grace from you, cry to you to
forgive us these sins and all others. Wash us clean and renew our ways
and means, for Christ's sake. Amen.¹
